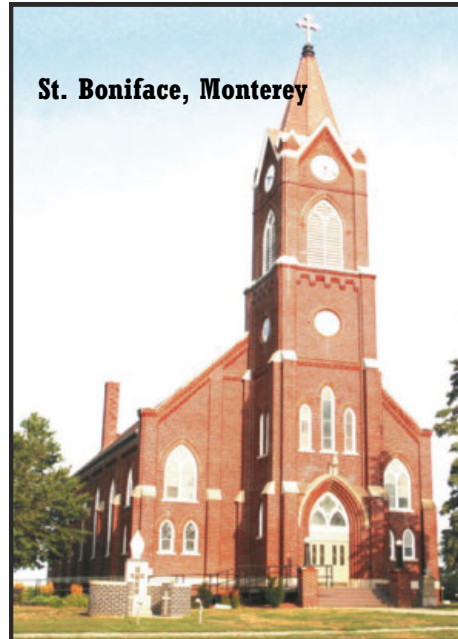
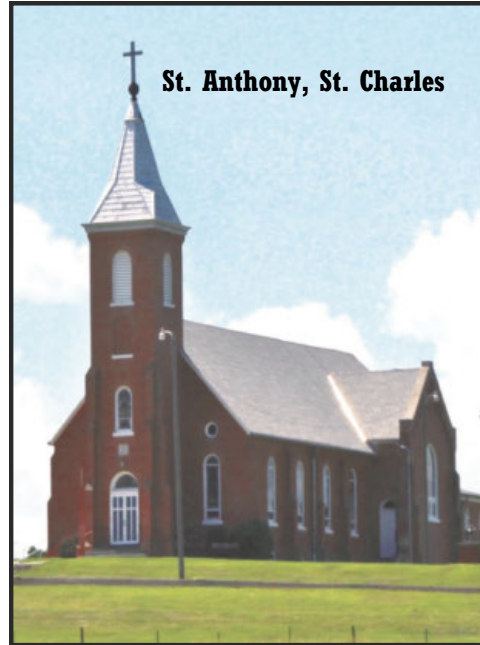

PADRE'S PONDERINGS

PARISH MISSION— Many parishes offer a Parish Mission with a speaker giving talks over three consecutive evenings during Lent. SPIRITUAL INSIGHT— The readings for the second week of Lent give us reasons for our faith. First, God promises Abram descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky. This moves Abram to put his faith in the Lord and we who believe in God are the descendants of Abram are the fulfilment of this promise. Hence, one reason for our faith is knowing that God fulfills His promises. Second, Paul encourages the Philippians "to stand firm in the Lord" for "our citizenship is in heaven." Our desire for heaven is an additional reason for our faith. Third, Jesus is transfigured before Peter, John, and James giving them a glimpse of His heavenly body. We profess in the Creed of believing in "the resurrection of the body." Accordingly, the Transfiguration is a glimpse of what the resurrection of the body will be. When Jesus comes again and a soul is reunited with its resurrected body it will be gloriously transfigured in a similar way. Thus, a third reason for our faith is in the belief of the resurrected body. May these reasons lead us to a deeper faith in God "who is our light and our salvation."



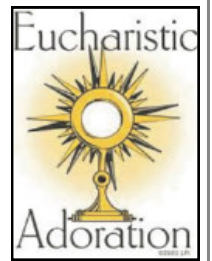
