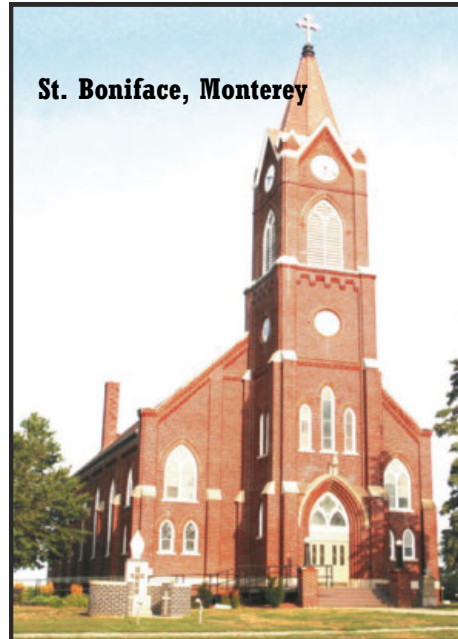
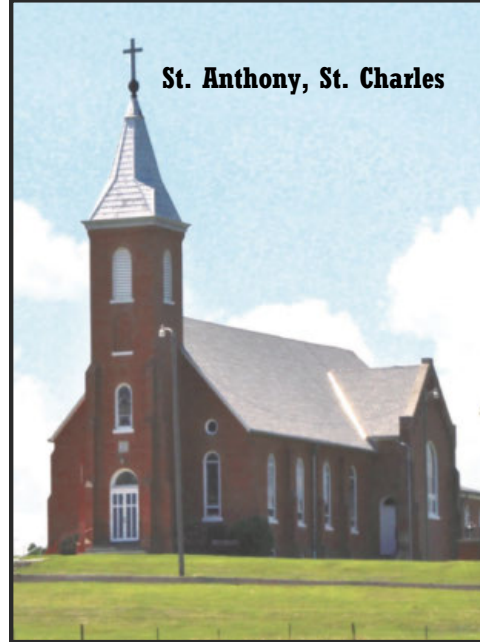

This Sunday there is a great opportunity to experience the mercy of God through the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Penance during the Parish Reconciliation Service. Whether it has been one week or several years, I pray that you will take part in this sacrament of mercy so that you can enter into the mysteries of Holy Week with a clean slate renewed in spirit.

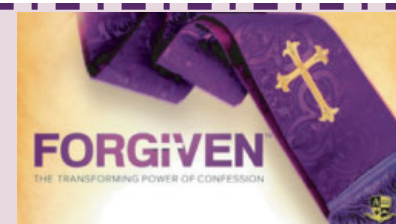

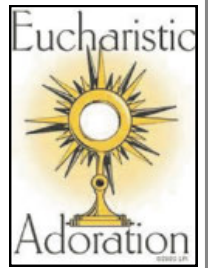
