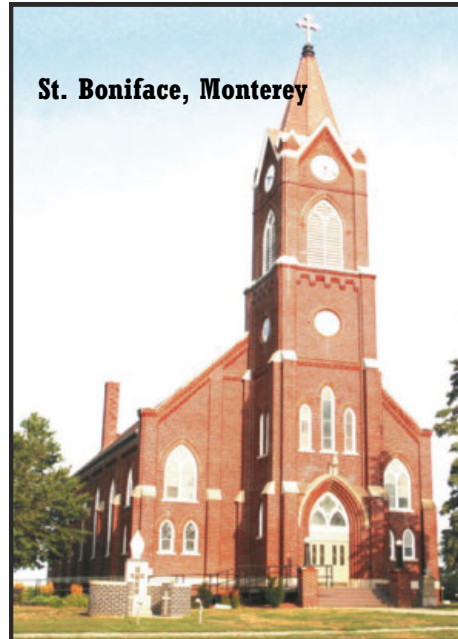
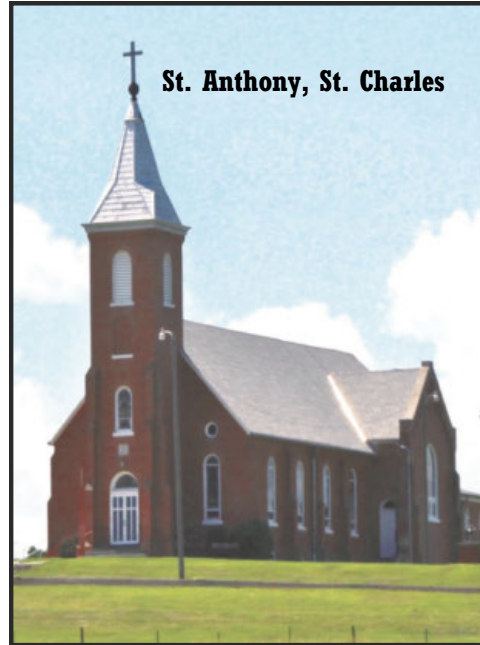

Finally, Jesus gave the disciples the Holy Spirit so they could be his agents of mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation: "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them." Thousands of years later, we continue to receive Christ's mercy in the confession (Magnificat, April 2022).*

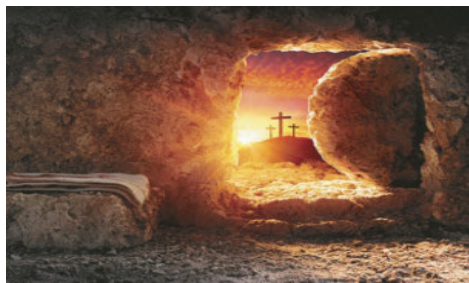

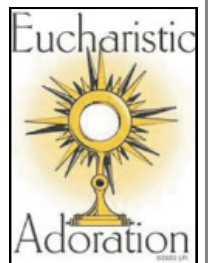

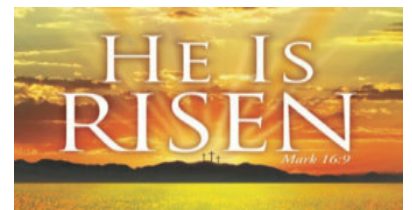
