#### **PADRE'S PONDERINGS**

**CONFIRMATION** was this past Wednesday on April 27th. Please pray that our candidates respond to the grace offered in this sacrament to fully live their faith. **FIRST HOLY COMMUNION** will be celebrated this Sunday, May 1st at 10:00am, 11:30am, and 2:00pm. May witnessing our youth receive the Most Holy Eucharist for the first time remind us of the gift of Jesus we have the opportunity to receive at each Mass we attend.

**ST MARYS PARISH COUNCIL AND GACC SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS** will be held this weekend April 30th and May 1st. A ballot will be placed in the pews for parishioners 18 and older to vote. Thank you to all those who accepted nominations.

**GRADUATION** will be next Sunday, May 8th. Let us keep our graduates in prayer as they transition in the next phase of their lives.

**WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS** is next Sunday, May 8th. Because of Graduation we will not have a particular service to pray for vocations, but I invite you to pray on your own for vocations. There is a *Prayer for Vocations* on the back cover of the *Breaking Bread* book that you can pray.

**FIRST FRIDAY AND SATURDAY DEVOTION—** The past couple of months people have asked me about the First Friday and Saturday devotions. The First Friday devotion is associated with the Sacred Heart of Jesus, while the First Saturday devotion is associated with the Immaculate Heart of Mary. These devotions arose from separate private revelations; hence, are not binding Catholic doctrine that everyone must follow. They are meant to be offered as reparation for the sins, sacrileges, and irreverence to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Condition to fulfill the First Friday devotion are as follows:

- 1. Receive Holy Communion on nine consecutive first Fridays of the month.
- 2. Go to confession within 8 days before or after the first Friday
- 2. Having the intention, at least implicitly, of making reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for all the sinfulness and ingratitude of men.

Conditions to fulfill the First Saturday Devotion are as follows:

- 1. Have the intention of consoling the Immaculate Heart in a spirit of reparation.
- 2. Go to confession within eight days before or after the first Saturday.
- 3. Receive Holy Communion on five consecutive first Saturdays.
- 4. Say five decades of the Holy Rosary.
- 5. Meditate for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Holy Rosary with the goal of keeping Our Lady company.

To help you fulfill these requirements, I will be hearing confessions beginning at 8:00am and concluding with a Communion service at 8:50am on May 7th. You can also go to confession at the normally scheduled times and Mass on Saturday evening to fulfill the requirements.

SPIRITUAL INSIGHT— "I'm going fishing." I associate these words of Peter with looking to the past. Jesus had appeared to Peter and the other disciples twice before yet they were hesitant to go out and tell others the Good News that Jesus has risen from the dead. In fact, they locked themselves in the upper room for fear of being arrested because they were followers of Christ. On this day, Peter rather than going out and doing what Jesus had asked, he looks to the past, goes back to his old way of life, goes back to what he knows—his comfort zone. Often times we do the same, we know that we are supposed to tell others about Jesus, but we are reluctant and lock ourselves in the upper room of fear. Rather than responding to our baptismal call to go make disciples of all nations, we go back to our old way of life, what we know, our comfort zone in order to avoid the possibility of rejection or criticism. In those times when we are hesitant to follow the call of the Lord, we must press into Him and be open to the grace to overcome whatever it is holding us back from inviting others into a relationship with Christ. As we continue our Easter journey do not look back to the past, the old way of life, but look to the new life Jesus offers and share that life with others.


