PADRE'S PONDERINGS

SPIRITUAL INSIGHT— It has been one of those weeks. We have all had them—the work is piling up, the deadlines are approaching, decisions need to be made—and we think, “How am I going to get everything finished” or “What am I going to do?” One might even call out “God, take this all away from me.” Then hopefully it hits you, “Why didn't I do that in the first place?” Why didn't I take it to prayer and rather than ask God to take it away, invite Him into the situation. So that what I did, I took all that has been going on this week to prayer. At first it didn't seem like any of the stress was subsiding, but when you least expect it, when your writing a spiritual insight for the bulletin and look at Gospel for Sunday which had the line: “Do not let your hearts be troubled.” My first thought was, “Okay God I know I'm not supposed to let my heart be troubled, but that is not what I'm experiencing now so what are you going to do about it?” It's amazing what a short prayer like that will do because it might just lead you to a reflection that goes like this: “*Too many anxious Christians today think that their efforts to preach and teach and enter their outward activities can do more to save the world than the surrender of their souls to God, to become Christ-bearers*” (Carol Houselander, May 2022, *Magnificat*). It begs the question, why am I trying to do all this on my own, why am I not surrendering it to God and asking for His guidance, why am I not asking others for help? In the big picture of things why am I putting all this pressure on myself when God does not even expect it of me. Yes, we all have responsibilities that we need to fulfill, but God wants to be part of it with us. Thus the next time you are having one of those weeks, don't forget to surrender it to God. With that being said, the bulletin deadline is upon me so the rest of the space below will not be filled and that's okay.

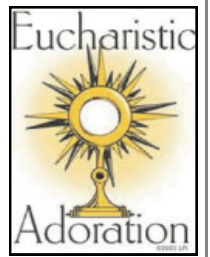
