

PADRE'S PONDERINGS

JOF MASS SCHEDULE Last week the new Mass schedule that will begin July 1 for our Family of Parishes was communicated. I also mentioned the realization that you will have many questions and concerns that could not be addressed in the bulletin. Thus I want to remind that you can ask any of the priests of our Family of Parishes and we will answer the best we can. Moreover, if you would like, Jim Jansen and Whitney Bradley from the Archdiocese will be hosting a meeting at the GA Cafeteria in West Point this Thursday, March 30 at 7:00pm to answer questions and hear concerns about the proposal. If you plan to attend this meeting I want you to know that regardless of your comments the decision that the Archdiocese has made regarding the Mass locations will not change. The priests of our family along with the FPPT tried with no avail. I know that this information is difficult to receive and will have different impact for each one of us. It is important to share those thoughts, feelings, and desires with our Lord and be open to the response He has for each one of us.

SPIRITUAL INSIGHT—In the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead, we notice that Jesus knows that Lazarus is sick and could heal him, but purposefully waits until he dies before going to the place where he was. At first it might seem cruel for Jesus to do this, but as He says it "is for the glory of God." Hence, it is hindsight that after Lazarus dies and is risen that we understand what Jesus meant. If we relate this to the spiritual life, one can recognize how sin is a spiritual death and although Jesus does not desire sin to rule one's life He permits it as not to impede free will. Often times that person may hit rock bottom before reaching out to God, but when and if he/she does reach out to God there can be what seems to be a miraculous conversion and change of life. God frees them from bondage of sin that had him/her bound like a burial cloth and they are risen to new life. If you know anybody who has had an experience like this then it gives hope. But it should also be a reminder that we should also examine our spiritual life to recognize where we may be bound up by sin, turn to the Lord asking for forgiveness especially in the sacrament of reconciliation, and be risen to new life free from sin.


