Letter from Fr. Kris

MERRY CHRISTMAS!

We can now officially offer each other this greeting! I know it's something we normally do well before Christmas, but now it's official! For the past four weeks, we've been preparing our hearts for the Lord's birth and making more room in our lives for Him. We're challenged by the stories of Jesus' birth when we heard that there was no room at the inn to make sure there's room in our hearts for the newborn King.

Today is born a Savior, Christ the Lord! When the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us, we were given the greatest gift ever. God so loved the world that He sent His only Son, not to condemn the world, but to redeem it. God knew the mess of sin and death we had gotten ourselves into and wanted to rescue us. He wants us to be happy, and as we all know, sin steals our joy; it makes us sad.

In the newborn Savior of the world, forgiveness and mercy have entered the world. Through the Word Incarnate, and his miraculous birth, we also get a glimpse into the infinitude of the love of the Father. We see that God wants us to be with Him for all eternity. We see that, in His humility, the Son entered into a fallen humanity to restore our relationship with the triune God. He lowered Himself so that He might raise us up to the glory and happiness He wants us to receive.

That little bundle of God is the greatest gift we could receive. Think back on all the time spent trying to find exactly the right gifts for family and friends. Purchasing things they either want or need, gifts that show our care for them. All that is just a tiny glimpse into the love that God has for us.
