

Are the Holidays Difficult?

For many people, the winter holidays are a time of joy, celebration, and connection with loved ones. There is an expectation - from society, the media and those around us - of constant cheer around the holidays. For many people, though, that's not their reality. The holidays can also be a very difficult and emotionally charged time, for many, many reasons.

The holidays portray an ideal of what family and happiness are supposed to look like. Many of us feel like we don't belong - be it with our families we grew up with, or the traditional customs and norms that are touted during this time of year. Stress and anxiety can also come from being with family members who you'd rather not be with, complicated or traumatic experiences, feeling pressure to buy gifts and related financial worries, feeling overwhelmed by social situations, or reminders of memories of loved ones who have passed away. The holidays can also intensify feelings of loneliness. Struggles with depression and anxiety can be magnified during the holidays. If you struggle with seasonal depression, the holidays can be particularly challenging.

Like many parents, Mary & Joseph remained committed to their parenting vocation, celebrating its joys and hopes, embracing its pain and anxiety. Their example of holiness isn't ethereal; it is borne of their interior freedom and radical commitment to their roles as parents even in the face of difficulties and challenges. They didn't have all the answers. In fact, in raising Jesus they learned what it meant to be a family—not a perfect or holy family, but a family of mutual love, care, and sacrifice. As Francis reminds us, holiness is manifest "in those parents who raise their children with immense love" (Gaudete et Exsultate).

Today, the feast of the Holy Family offers an opportunity to reflect on our call to holiness. Holiness is a path for each person to discover, not a portrait to be copied and imitated sheepishly: "The important thing is that each believer discern his or her own path, that they bring out the very best of themselves, the most personal gifts that God has placed in their hearts" (Gaudete et Exsultate).

To Heed God's Will

Jesus, our most loving redeemer,
You came to enlighten the world
with your teaching and example.
You willed to spend the greater part
of Your life in humble obedience to
Mary and Joseph
in the poor home of Nazareth.
In this way, You sanctified that
family, which was to be an example
for all Christian families.
Graciously accept our family,
which we dedicate and consecrate
to You this day.
Be pleased to protect, guard, and
keep it in holy fear, in peace,
and in the harmony of Christian
charity.
By conforming ourselves to the
Divine model of Your family,
may we attain to eternal happiness.
Amen.

The Christmas season runs from Christmas Eve Evening through the day before the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which is the Sunday after the Epiphany. Liturgically, we celebrate an octave of Christmas, which is 8 days. The octave of Christmas ends on January 1, which is a holy day of obligation for the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God.

The Epiphany (when the kings show up to see Baby Jesus) is traditionally celebrated on January 6, but it gets moved to the closest Sunday. This year it is celebrated on Sunday, January 2nd. There are 12 days from December 25 through January 5 that lead up to the traditional Epiphany. These days are referred to as the "12 days of Christmas", but because the Epiphany moves around (like this year) there aren't exactly 12 days. Maybe consider leaving your tree up a little longer this year to celebrate the whole season! The Vatican leaves the tree and nativity up until February 2nd. Many families and Churches celebrate Christmas up to this date.

Here are the key dates of the Christmas Season:

December 24 – Christmastide or Christmas Season begins at the first Christmas Vigil Mass

December 25 – Birth of Jesus!

December 25 to January 1 (Octave of Christmas) – the 8 days of Christmas that we feast and celebrate

January 1 – Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God (Holy Day of Obligation)

December 25 through January 5 – "Twelve Days of Christmas" that lead up to Epiphany (because date of Epiphany moves from year to year there are not always exactly 12 days)

January 2 – Epiphany: Three Kings arrive to see baby Jesus

January 9 – Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. The day after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, we return to Ordinary Time (green)

February 2 – Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also referred to as Candlemas, is about Mary's presentation in the temple for Purification. Presentation of Jesus to Simeon (and prophecy of Simeon) also occurred here.



We Are Family in the Sight of God

To ponder the mystery of life.
Matthew 2:13-15, 19-23

We hear a lot about Mary in our Catholic tradition but only a few times do we concentrate on Joseph, Mary's husband and Jesus's earthly father. Joseph had his own decisions to make. 
