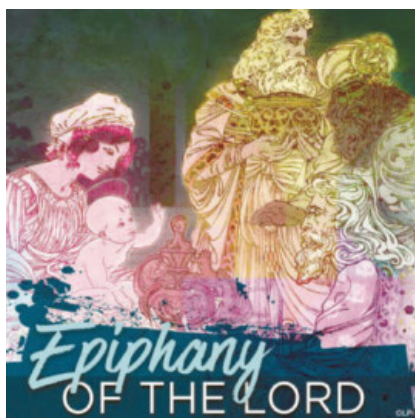

Epiphany Door Blessing

Epiphany is Sunday, January 2nd

It's very easy to bless your house for the Epiphany, and you don't need a priest - you can do it yourself! The Epiphany door blessing includes symbols for all 3 kings, plus the numbers from the current year marked on your front door in chalk.

Here's what the chalked markings on the door mean: The "20" is for the first 2 numbers of the year, the 3 letters are the first Initial of each of the kings (Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar) and the last 2 numbers are the last half of the year. The "C, M, B also stands for the Latin blessing *Christus Mansionem Benedicat* which means "May Christ Bless this House".

Pick up a Epiphany Blessing Bag in the back of the Narthex next weekend (January 1st & 2nd) to take home and bless your home! Bags include, chalk, holy water bottle (to fill), and prayer guide.

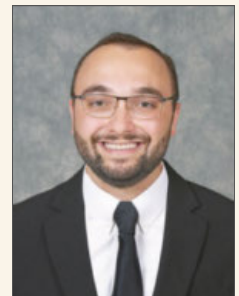

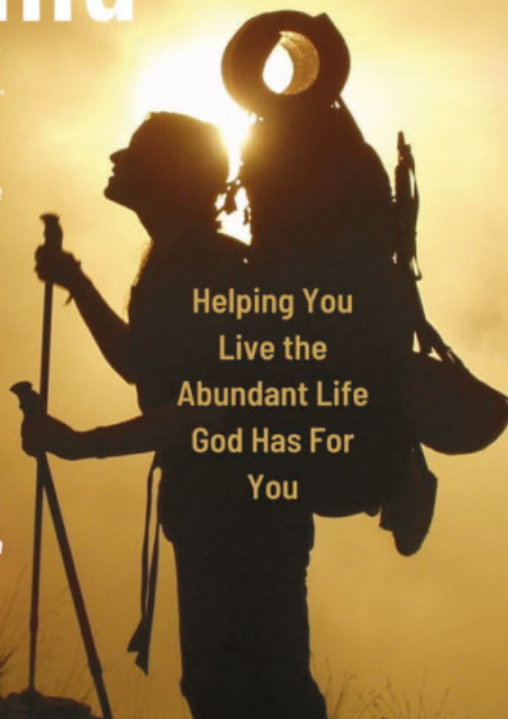

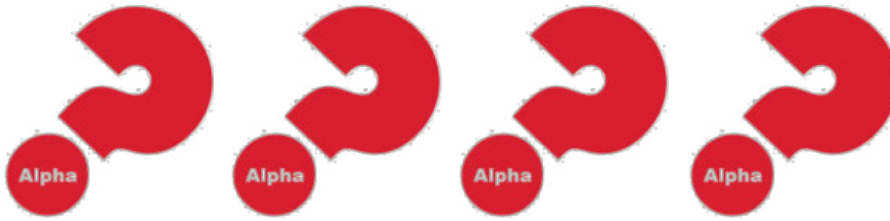
Live Unbound

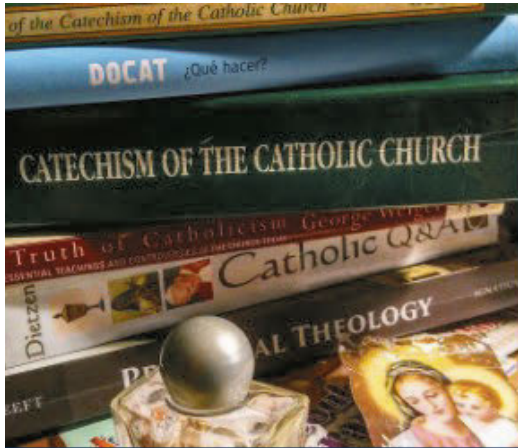

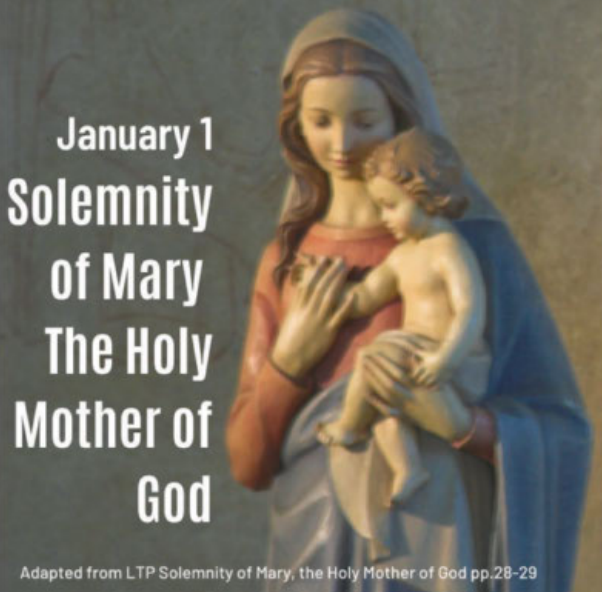

OUR FAMILY OF FAITH In Real Life



The definition of the word "Epiphany" is a divine or supernatural manifestation. The feast of the Epiphany celebrates the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles as represented by the Magi (three kings.) Who were the three kings? It is believed that they were skilled at watching the stars. They knew about the many prophecies that spoke of the Messiah and when they saw the bright star they knew something special was about to happen, that the Messiah had finally arrived. The three king (Magi) traveled for a long time, roughly three years. Their first stop was to visit King Herod in Jerusalem because they thought that the King of the Jews would be born in a palace. Herod was furious because he did not know that Jesus' kingdom would be a heavenly one and he thought that his power was in danger. King Herod then secretly met with the Magi and asked them exactly when the star appeared. He then told them that they could find the King of the Jews in Bethlehem. The Magi set out for Bethlehem and eventually they came to the house where Jesus, Mary, and Joseph were staying.
