To honor Mary's role as intercessor, both for the bridegroom's family in our Gospel story today and for us, pray the Rosary or at least one decade of the Rosary as a family today. If you aren't regularly praying the Rosary as a family, this is a great time to start!

The new year is a great time to teach your child the prayers of the Rosary. Start with one decade and work up to a Full Rosary by Lent or the end of the year. Remember, it's about purpose, not perfection and nothing for God is ever wasted! We teach our children so many things as parents, be sure to make the Rosary one of them.



OUR FAMILY OF FAITH



Mary brings a problem to her son's attention at a wedding they were attending. What was the problem?

Running out of wine at a wedding isn't really an emergency today, when you could just run to the store and buy more. In Jesus' time, however, it was a huge problem to run out of wine at a celebration like a wedding. Back then they couldn't just run and buy more. They would have been considered poor hosts if they ran out of food and drink. Mary wishes to help them so that they are not embarassed. She brings this up to her son, and even after he tells her not to interfere, she insists that something should be done. She instructs the servants to do whatever Jesus tells them to do, and they listen.

If you were at this wedding and heard what was being said among Mary, Jesus and the servants, do you think you would pay attention to what happened next?

John 2:1-12

The disciples of Jesus were with him. They paid attention. And when the miracle happened, they were able to put their faith in Jesus. They knew that Jesus was special and listened to him preach, but at the beginning they didn't always believe that he was the promised Messiah. They needed a sign to help them believe so Jesus gave them one. What was the miracle?






