Living the Easter Season Preparing for Pentecost



We prepare for Christmas by celebrating the four weeks of waiting in Advent, and we prepare for Easter by undergoing our own 40-day journey into the desert of Lent. The joyous feast of the time of Easter is its own form of both Lent (penance/preparation) and Advent (joyful waiting), as we approach the feast day our Church began its mission, Pentecost. This time of preparation serves as a reminder of the first feast of Pentecost and also leads us to celebrate the fact that the Holy Spirit is already with us, all of us, always. Here are **8** ways to prepare your own heart for the feast!

1. **Refamiliarize yourself with the gifts of the Holy Spirit.** Ask the Holy Spirit to help you sift through your own charisms and gifts.
2. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you through an examination of conscience and prepare yourself to receive the Sacrament of Penance.
3. **Participate in the church's oldest novena,** the Novena to the Holy Spirit.
4. **Help renew the face of the earth.** Go out and share your faith with someone. Invite someone back to Mass. Be not afraid to speak.
5. **Gladden the Holy Spirit.** Spend time serving God by serving others.
6. **Steward time well.** How much time can you afford to spend with God?
7. **Spend time thanking the trinity.** Take up your rosary and simply say "Thank you, God the Father", on each one of the beads.
8. **Silence and Solitude.** Set a timer for 5 minutes and be silent and still. Give Jesus permission to minister to your heart.

Jesus Ascends into Heaven!



On Thursday, we celebrated the feast of the Ascension when Jesus went up, body and soul, into Heaven. Forty days after Jesus rose from the dead He took his disciples up to a big hill and told them that He was going to send the Holy Spirit to them soon. Then He went up into the sky and disappeared behind the clouds.

At first, it seems kind of sad that Jesus left His friends, doesn't it? But how could they be sad when Jesus was returning with joy to His Father in Heaven?

Sometimes we are sad when somebody we love dies or moves away, and that's ok. We can't stay with our friends forever in this world, but we will in Heaven. Jesus is there waiting for us to come and live forever with Him and all of our friends.

So we celebrate Jesus' going into Heaven, and remember that He has gone ahead of us to make a place for us when we die.

In the Gospel story today, we hear Jesus praying to his Father in heaven. He prays that we will all become connected to one another, just as he is one with the Father and that the Father is one with Jesus his Son. Let's think about what it means to be connected with others or part of something. **What are some groups you belong to? What does it feel like to be part of a team or a group?**

Teams or groups can help us feel connected to others because we work together to meet a goal. When people feel part of a team, they want to work together to make it the best it can be. Our attitudes and actions as part of a team affects others and can be positive or negative. Jesus's prayer today is about how we can all become one in him. It will take more than just one group of disciples to spread the Good News. It takes our leaders and every single one of us: men, women and children. All of us are disciples on the path to holiness, following the teachings of Jesus to the best of our abilities. Jesus not only prays for the followers who were his close friends, but also for everyone else who will have faith because of what these followers will say about Jesus!

The first followers actions, attitudes and words could bring people into a community of believers, or they could make future believers turn away. If we are happy about being followers of Jesus, then we need to show this joy in our actions and attitudes, always! **Who did Jesus send to us as our helper or guide? How does the Holy Spirit help us to know God and use our gifts on behalf of God? What do you think of Jesus' prayer?**

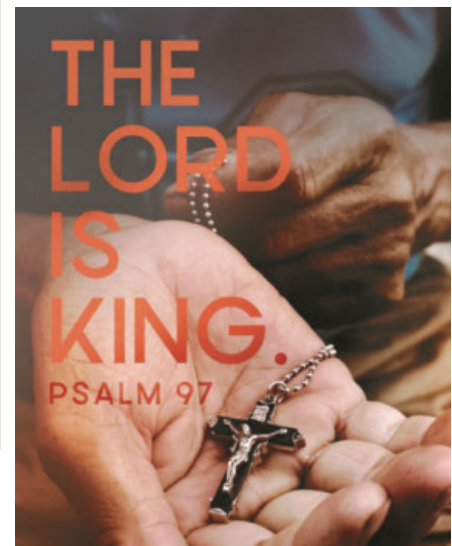
