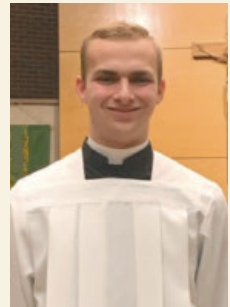

Living the Easter Season Pentecost: Happy Birthday Church

This weekend we celebrate the feast of Pentecost. If you were to rank feast days in order, Easter would have the most importance. Pentecost would be the second most important Church feast day.

**“Today we have arrived at the peak of all blessings,
we have reached the capital of feasts, we have
obtained the very fruit of the Lord’s promise.”**

-St. John Chrysostom

It was on Pentecost that the Holy Spirit, promised by Jesus, first came to the disciples. It is the Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, that helped early Christians to fearlessly preach the Good News. When the Holy Spirit descended on the disciples in the form of wind and fire as they hid in the Upper Room, they were changed into courageous souls who preached the Gospel throughout their lifetimes.

Pentecost is a Greek word that means “fiftieth day.” Today marks fifty days after Easter. Pentecost is often known as the “birthday of the Church” because it was on this day that God’s final covenant with humankind was complete. Through the coming of the Holy Spirit, the first Christians could look back on the events in the life of Jesus with new insight and see how they fit in with all that had been foretold by the prophets of the Old Testament. Stamped with the Spirit’s approval, so to speak, they could preach confidently that “Jesus is Lord!” and that Jesus was equal with the Father, true God from true God.

Dear St. Pat's Parish Family,

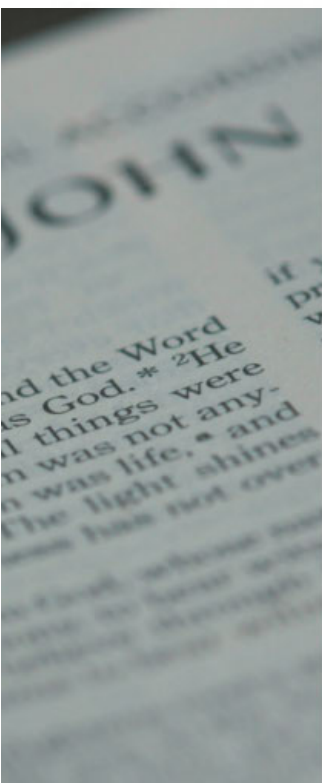
Our home recently caught fire, and after everything went up in smoke, all of you became our light with your good works: texts, calls,

Family life is filled with the ordinary; raising children, day-to-day routines and tasks. But in all of its ordinariness, God allows us time to discover the extraordinary ways our Catholic faith gives meaning and purpose to our everyday lives.

Join us for Family Faith Formation 2022-2023. Sessions will be held the first three Wednesdays of the month at 4:30 & 6:30pm for 60-minutes. As you celebrate Pentecost as a family, take some time to talk about the Fruits of the Spirit: Love, Joy, Peace, Kindness, Patience, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness, Self Control.

Talk about what a person would be like if they had these qualities. How does a person show he or she is loving, joyful, peaceful? How would a person act who is patient, kind and good? What kinds of things might a person do if he or she was faithful, gentle and possessed self-control?

Then discuss how the Holy Spirit can help a person live as a follower of Jesus. Ask if they can share a story of someone who has acted heroically or did a good deed that others recognized (because it helped so many people). Ask them to share how they are inspired by the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit can help us do amazing things!

Happy Birthday to the Church! Today is a joyous celebration because we remember how the Holy Spirit came upon the first disciples. They were afraid of being punished like Jesus was and huddled in a room praying that God would do something amazing. And God did! God sent the Holy Spirit so that Jesus' followers could feel energized and filled with courage. Renewed by the Holy Spirit, Jesus' followers were able to come out of that room and begin to proclaim all that they knew about Jesus. Have you ever been afraid or nervous about something, but then found courage to do it?

We receive the Holy Spirit when we receive the Sacrament of Baptism (and other sacraments as well). Every so often, we hear a story about someone moved to do something heroic. These stories are signs that the Holy Spirit is present with us. In the Gospel, prior to the Holy Spirit coming, Jesus comes to the disciples. He breathes on them and tells them they are receiving the Holy Spirit. Jesus also addresses the forgiveness of sins. He tells the disciples present in that room, that if they forgive another person's sins, those sins are forgiven. But if they don't forgive, then the person's sins are not forgiven. What Jesus is saying is that we all, all in the Spirit, have the power to forgive or not to forgive.
