

Jesus-Filled Summer

"Ponder the fact that God has made you a gardener, to root out vice and plant virtue." -St. Catherine of Siena

Whether it's a vegetable garden or a flower garden, the natural growth of plants teaches us about the beauty of God's nurturing hand. Consider planting a Mary Garden, and allow our Blessed Mother to guide you. Creating a Mary Garden of your own isn't difficult. Use a statue of the Virgin Mary as the focal point, then group Mary garden plants around it. However, if you don't want to use a statue, you don't have to. Instead, use some tall Mary garden plants as the focal point. Lilies or roses work well for this.

Generally, the plants represent some aspect of Mary's clothing, home, or person. Some symbolize aspects of spiritual life. For example, according to legend, the Angel Gabriel was holding a lily when he told Mary that she was to be the mother of Jesus, thus lilies signify purity and grace. Roses also symbolize Mary as the Queen of Heaven. The following plants are suggestions for inclusion in your garden: Marigold means Mary's gold, Zinnia means the Virgin, Daisy is Mary's flower, Geranium means our beautiful lady, Iris symbolize Mary's sword of sorrow, Petunia is Our Lady's praises, or Geraniums which are Madonna's pins.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Catholic Life Explained...

Ouestion:

Why do we have a liturgical season called ordinary time? Can you explain?

Answer:

Ordinary time is the longest season of the liturgical year. It begins the Monday after January 6, the Epiphany, and goes until the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent. That period can last anywhere from five to eight weeks, depending on when Easter is celebrated. Ordinary time picks up again the Monday after Pentecost Sunday and lasts from 23 to 27 weeks, until the end of the liturgical year, the Saturday before Advent begins.

Why the name ordinary? "Ordinary" is not in contrast to "extraordinary" or "special" but rather stresses the Latin language notion of "ordinal" or numbered Sundays. The Latin title for the season, tempus ordinarium, conveys the sense that this time of the year is measured or numbered time. Measured time can allude simply to the numbered Sundays, or the notion that these Sundays are a "measured" time to deepen and immerse ourselves completely in the realities of Jesus' incarnation, ministry, passion, death, and resurrection. Ordinary time offers us the opportunity to connect the ordinary lived experiences of our lives with those of Jesus, who modeled for us how to live a truly human existence. ©LPi






