- Scheduling is flexible and can be decided by you

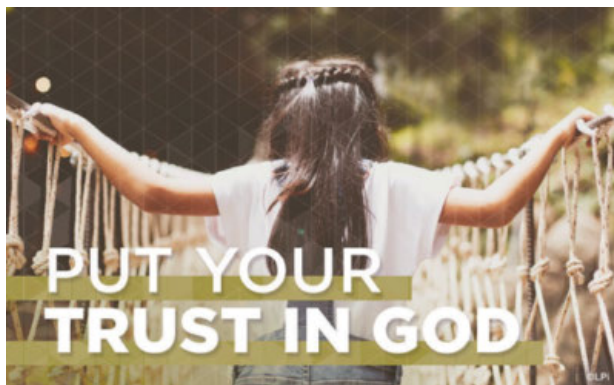

BAPTISM PREP CLASS

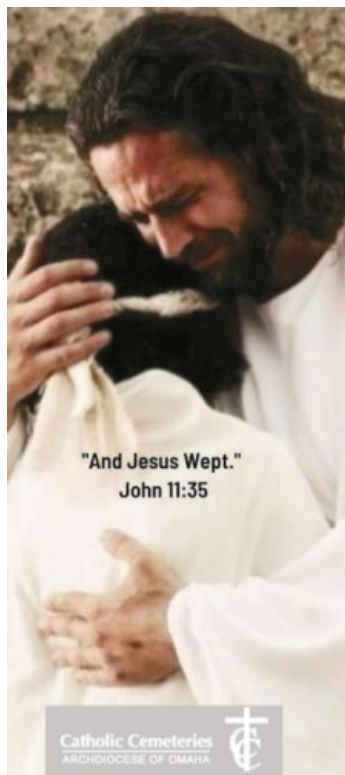

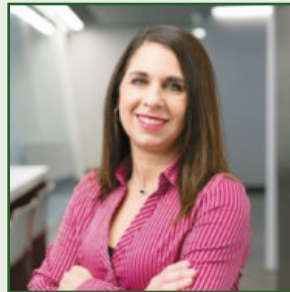

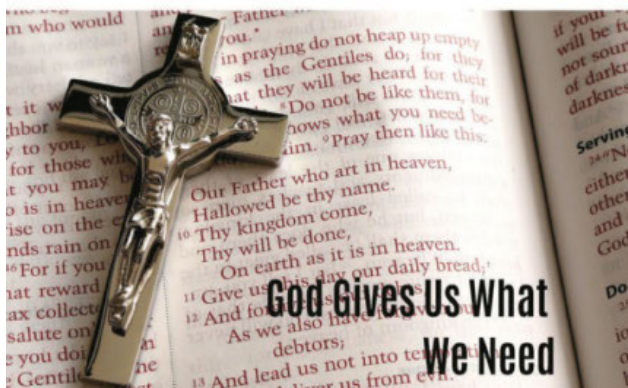

In today's Gospel reading, the disciples asked Jesus to teach them how to pray, so he taught them the "Our Father."

In the first part of the "Our Father" we give glory to God by praising Him, and in the second part we ask Him for the things we need. First we ask for our daily bread. Things can be asking both for things like food that our bodies need, and for spiritual things as well, especially Holy Communion. Next we ask for forgiveness of our sins and for God to keep us away from temptations and evil.

Jesus said that if a father on earth would give him children the things that they need, then God, who is our Father in Heaven, will certainly give us what we need. All He wants us to do is show that we trust in Him by asking Him.

Make sure you say the "Our Father" everyday to praise God our Father and ask Him for everything you need.

PreS - K

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

- Montessori based catechesis for the young child, ages 3-6
- Kindergarten parents can opt into either CGS or Family Faith
- Classes will meet three Wednesdays per month (September thru May) at 4:30pm and 6:30pm during Family Faith Formation (max 24 students) per session.
- Class size is limited to 12 students per session and will be filled on a first come, first served basis

K-5th

Family Faith Formation

- Families will come to campus three Wednesdays per month at 4:30pm or 6:30pm (September thru May) for an hour-long session.
- Child must attend with a parent every week. Any child without a parent chaperone will have parents called and be sent home.
- **Week 1:** Parents and children will gather together for opening prayer and to an introduction for the month's theme. Children will be dismissed to attend grade level specific catechesis. Parents will stay and prepare for the week 2 activities.
- **Week 2:** Families will participate in the activity that was prepared for in week 1 with other families in small groups.
- **Week 3:** Parents and children will gather together for an opening prayer. Children will be dismissed to attend grade level specific catechesis. Parents will participate in faith sharing small groups and other adult faith formation events, or parents are welcome to attend in the classroom with their child.

6-8th

Middle School Formation

If your child was baptized here at St. Patrick's, please notify the school office, and we will print a copy for you. This information is needed by July 29, 2022.

FORMS DUE BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS - New families need to provide a current copy of your child(ren)'s immunization records. If you have a child going into Kindergarten or 7th grade, we also need a copy of the required physical exam. If you are transferring to St. Patrick's from out of state, you'll need to submit immunizations and a physical exam from a Nebraska healthcare provider. These documents are required to be on file before your child(ren) start school in August. Completed forms can be dropped off in the office (M-F, 9am-12pm), scanned and emailed to nurse@stpatselfhorn.org, faxed to (402) 763-9530, or mailed. Contact the school office with any questions.

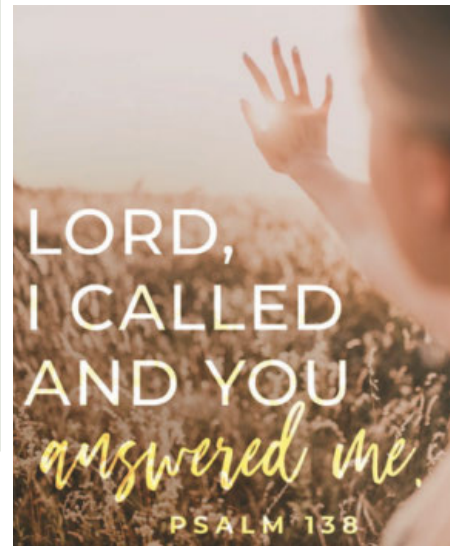

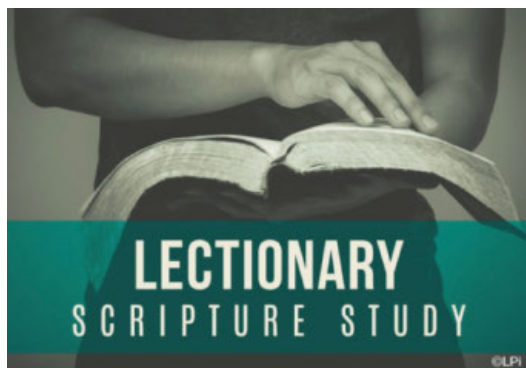
