In today's Gospel reading, a man tells Jesus that his brother is being unfair to him. But Jesus knows the man is just being greedy, so He tells him the parable of the rich farmer. One year he had such a good harvest that he couldn't fit it all into his barns. He tore down his old barn and built new ones, so that he could store his food for many years. But just when he thought he would be able to rest and enjoy his food, God told him that he would die.

The parable is a warning against being greedy. Jesus is not saying that we should not have some food or that we shouldn't save our money. He is just telling us to remember that we are going to die one day, and then everything we saved is going to be useless for us. He wants us to use the things we have wisely but not be too attached to them.

Think of something that is really special to you. How would you feel if you lost it or it was taken away? Do your feelings show that you care too much about things? Try to think of your belongings in such a way that if you lost them, you wouldn't be too upset. After all, none of your stuff is going to matter when you die.

SUMMER OFFICE HOURS - The summer hours look a bit different this year. We are open from 9am – 12pm Monday through Friday in in August, up until the week school starts. During the month of July, we will be available by appointment. Please feel free to contact any of the administrators or office staff to schedule an appointment during the summer by calling the school or emailing. Voicemail & email are checked regularly.

2022-2023 PAPERWORK NEEDED – If your child is new to St. Patrick's this year, we will need a copy of his/her birth certificate and baptism certificate. You can send these to the school office or email them to: molson@stpatselkhorn.org. If your child was baptized here at St. Patrick's, please notify the school office, and we will print a copy for you. This information was needed by *July 29, 2022*.

FORMS DUE BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS - New families need to provide a current copy of your child(ren)'s immunization records. If you have a child going into Kindergarten or 7th grade, we also need a copy of the required physical exam. If you are transferring to St. Patrick's from out of state, you'll need to submit immunizations and a physical exam from a Nebraska healthcare provider. These documents are required to be on file before your child(ren) start school in August. Completed forms can be dropped off in the office (M-F, 9am-12pm), scanned and emailed to nurse@stpatselkhorn.org, faxed to (402) 763-9530, or mailed. Contact the school office with any questions.




