

### **BAPTISM PREP CLASS**



The Kingdom of God Cannot be Lost Luke 12:32-48

Have you ever had a prized possession? Like maybe a perfect toy? Now pretend that you've decided to let a friend borrow it. But your friend doesn't care about your toy nearly as much as you do, and they don't treat it very well. In fact, they break it. Was that very nice of your friend? What do you think – if you ever get another prized possession, will you let your friend borrow it again? Probably not. In fact, you might just decide to not let ANYONE borrow it.

But what if you had LOTS of prized possessions and you knew that you were always getting more, all the time, every day? Then you wouldn't be as scared about sharing your prized possession, right? Because you would know that even if one got damaged, you'd have plenty more on their way. You might even start sharing your things all over the place, right? Because you would no longer be so afraid of losing your prized possession.

This is why Jesus begins his teaching from today's scripture story with this line, "Be not afraid. It is God's good pleasure to give you the kingdom". God's kingdom – which is God's better way for us to live, right here, right now – is an even better gift than our most prized possessions. AND, this is not a gift that God gives just once, but ALL the time. God never stops offering us God's better way to live, even when we make a mistake and break it. In other words, we can't lose God's better way to live because God keeps offering it to us.

The best gift that God can give us, the kingdom of God, cannot be lost or stolen from us or broken by us. Because it can't be lost, stolen, or broken, that means we can share God's gift with those around us – over and over again. And that's the good news for today!

Family life is filled with the ordinary; raising children, day-to-day routines and tasks. But in all of its ordinariness, God allows us time to discover the extraordinary ways our Catholic faith gives meaning and purpose to our everyday lives.

**SUMMER OFFICE HOURS -** The summer hours look a bit different this year. We are open from 9am – 12pm Monday through Friday in in August, up until the week school starts. Please feel free to contact any of the administrators or office staff to schedule an appointment during the summer by calling the school or emailing. Voicemail & email are checked regularly.

**2022-2023 PAPERWORK NEEDED** – If your child is new to St. Patrick's this year, we will need a copy of his/her birth certificate and baptism certificate. You can send these to the school office or email them to: molson@stpatselkhorn.org. If your child was baptized here at St. Patrick's, please notify the school office, and we will print a copy for you. This information was needed by *July 29, 2022*.

**FORMS DUE BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS** - New families need to provide a current copy of your child(ren)'s immunization records. If you have a child going into Kindergarten or 7<sup>th</sup> grade, we also need a copy of the required physical exam. If you are transferring to St. Patrick's from out of state, you'll need to submit immunizations and a physical exam from a Nebraska healthcare provider. These documents are required to be on file before your child(ren) start school in August. Completed forms can be dropped off in the office (M-F, 9am-12pm), scanned and emailed to <a href="mailto:nurse@stpatselkhorn.org">nurse@stpatselkhorn.org</a>, faxed to (402) 763-9530, or mailed. Contact the school office with any questions.


