Many thanks for the prayers and support for the people of the Fondwa area of Haiti, especially following the brief presentations after Mass recently. **We are very happy to report that parishioners have generously given \$1260 in support of efforts to provide provisions for the veterinary clinic and pharmacy operated by our guest last year, Edrix Alcime.** Of this amount, \$700 has been forwarded through secure means directly to Edrix so that he can purchase supplies in Haiti. The remaining \$560 has been used in the local purchase of items which will be shipped to Haiti in due course, along with additional donated items. Further updates on the development of this project will be provided in the near future. Sincere thanks to all who have assisted with this important ministry to those in need.
