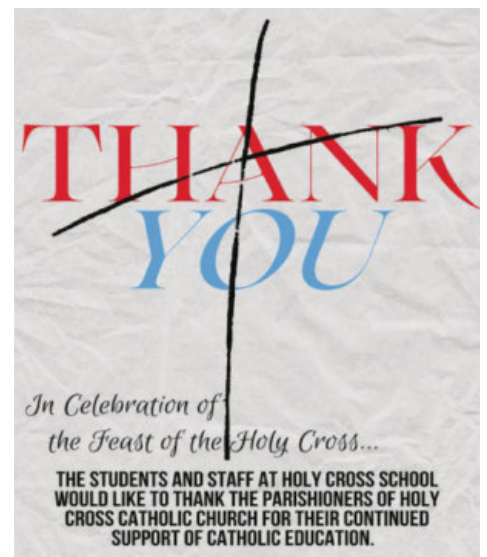

From Fr. Jerome...

*"Lift high the cross, the love
of Christ proclaimed, till all the
world adore His sacred name..."*

This beautiful song is one we
proudly sing at Holy Cross be-
cause it describes our joy and
gratitude in Jesus' love for us and triumph of
salvation. The cross is the gateway to holiness
and eternal life. Without it, we could not enter
heaven or know the depth of God's love for us.
It's like a newly engaged bride lifts her diamond
for others to see as a sign of her fiance's love
for her. It's the display of the Father's heart for
us and a reminder of the permanence of His
love and mercy! September 14 is the Feast of
the Triumph of the Holy Cross and since it is on
a Sunday, every church in the world will be
celebrating our feast! We should also keep in
mind that our church is in a cruciform shape, a
traditional architectural style whereby the very
body of the church layout is in the shape of a
cross. The feet would be down by the West
doors and the arms extending North and South
are the arms. The sanctuary, with the ambo and
altar, is where Christ's head and heart would be
to offer His words (ambo--Scripture) and body
(altar--Eucharist). I'm excited about our renova-
tion planned for next summer. As you may have
been able to tell from the architectural ren-
ditiion, there are 5 diamonds that will line the
floor to mark the 5 wounds of Jesus (3 nails,
spear in His side, and crown of thorns). Let us
prayerfully and joyfully lift high the cross of
Jesus in our prayer and courage in bearing all
things in Jesus. Death and the cross, are the
gate, which lead to the resurrection and new
life in Christ! *Alleluia!*

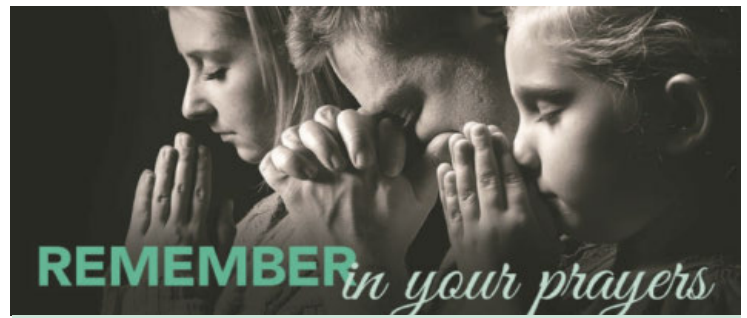

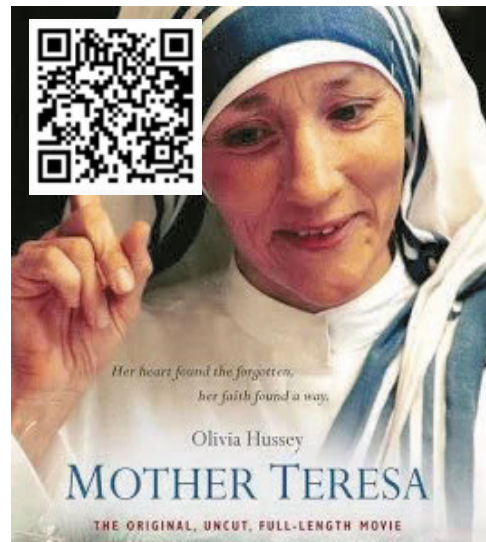
