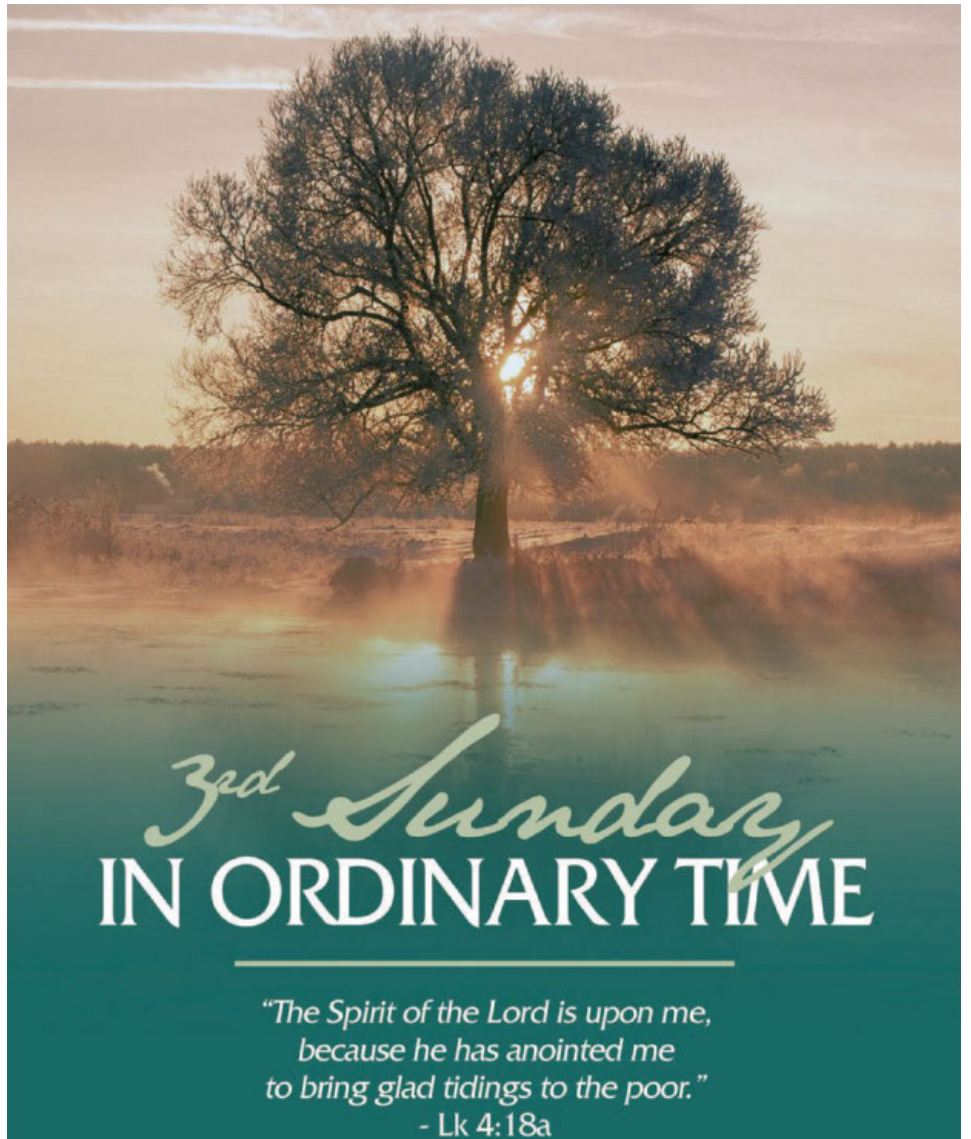

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Plant Your Works in the Word

One of the things about Scripture is that even the smallest word and shortest phrase can be critical to the overall message. When you take a quiet moment to rest with the Word, you find how quickly the most mundane sentence can reach out and grab you, pulling you into a deeper contemplation of some truth you hadn't even considered until then.

But we often fail to act as the Israelites in the Book of Nehemiah, standing before the Water Gate "listening attentively." Whether it's at Mass during the Liturgy of the Word or at home poring over the Bible, time after time we find ourselves less mindful than we could be. Our ears accept the sounds of the words and our eyes glance over the shape of the letters.

But are we mindful – truly?

The best answer is hopefully at least sometimes. There are always tasks to be completed, problems weighing on our minds that we can't quite give over to God. We lose ourselves in these things instead of in Scripture. We "clock in" with Bible reading instead of "diving in."

We can never forget that the words of the Lord are spirit and life. They are the soil that quickens the seed of all stewardship. There is no mindfulness, no prayer, no graciousness, no gratitude or accountability or sense of commitment unless there is the Word.

So let us pray today for mindfulness, that our every action will be grounded in the law of God – giving it true spirit and life.

FROM BISHOP POWERS

With the rising number of cases of the Omicron variant, I want to once again encourage everyone to do your part to help prevent the spread of COVID. In particular I strongly recommend:

The Brick Ministries

When area residents call one of our cluster parishes for assistance, we often refer them to The Brick. The BRICK's mission is to help people in need, providing compassionate, respectful help to families and individuals facing emergencies and crisis. We provide an assortment of food items, both non-perishable and fresh, to families in need. They may visit The BRICK's Food Shelf once each month, receiving three to five days' worth of groceries. This is emergency, supplemental food, which The BRICK obtains from the Federal Emergency Food Assistance Program, Second Harvest Food Bank, Wal-Mart's Feed America Program, and donations from area churches, community organizations, and individuals. The BRICK has four Food Shelf locations: Ashland, Cable, Cornucopia, and Mellen.

The Brick's Benevolence Manager works one on one with area residents who need short term aid. Together, they determine a plan, establish a workable budget, and set goals that will assist the family to move forward and avoid financial shortfalls in the future. When needed, the Benevolence office provides services that are not available elsewhere. With donations and matching funds from Northern State Bank's Make a Difference Foundation, the Salvation Army, area churches, and private individuals, The BRICK provides emergency shelter, fuel and utility assistance, rental assistance, and other emergency aid.

Bishop Powers has announced the Diocese of Superior plans for participating in the *Synod on Synodality* called by Pope Francis this past fall.

The Diocese of Superior formally began its participation in the Synod at an opening Mass at Our Lady of the Lake in Ashland on October 18th. Since then we have been praying the Synod Prayer to the Holy Spirit and offering a specific petition during the *Prayer of the Faithful*.

The next phase of participation will begin by gathering information from parishes around the diocese. I will be providing further information in future bulletins about our cluster's participation in the Synod process.

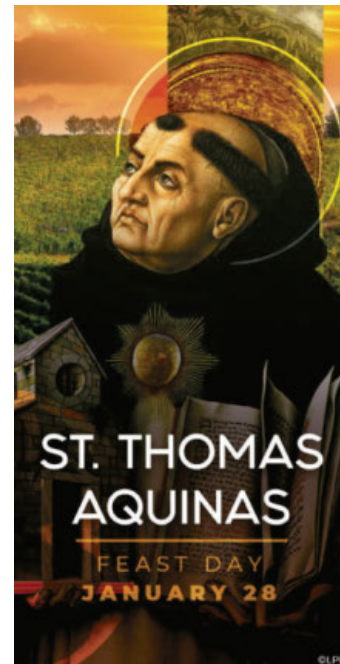
