Father's Focus

INTIMATE NIGHT

"O little town of Bethlehem, how still we see thee lie" These words of the popular Christmas hymn come to my mind as anticipate the kind of Christmas that we may have during this time of pandemic.

Imagine, if you will for a moment, what it was like for Mary, Joseph, and Jesus on the night that Jesus was born. Imagine just the three of them during the few hours following Jesus' birth ... the hours before the shepherds arrived, or the wise men showed up, or the angels began to sing.

Scripture does not tell us how long Mary and Joseph had alone with Jesus following his birth before all these other people arrived. But it would seem proper that Mary delivered Jesus in Joseph's presence alone; and that the three of them would have had time to ponder deeply about the great event that just took place. After all, Mary and Joseph were the only two people who really knew the magnitude of this moment. Mary had known from the moment of conception that she "will conceive in her womb and bear a son, and shall name Him Jesus" (Lk 1:31). And Joseph had a mighty struggle to believe Mary's words and was only finally convinced by a message he received through a dream. Thus, the two of them would have an amazing moment of intimacy with one another and with Jesus as they pondered the amazing mystery of God-made-man.

Perhaps this is what it is going to be like for our families. COVID restrictions have caused many of us to act cautiously. Many of us avoid large gatherings and even family gatherings. And while this may strike some as a sadness, I want to encourage you to treat the precious moments of small gatherings, even within one's own house, in the same way Jesus and Mary treated the first precious moments with Jesus: intimacy. This intimacy is the stillness we sing about in Bethlehem.

Yes, the COVID restrictions have meant fewer Christmas parties, fewer gatherings, and have locked many people in their homes either by themselves or with their household. But this does not mean we lose the spirit of Christmas intimacy. Perhaps we can consider these smaller gatherings, or even moments of isolation, as a new intimacy with the mystery of the God-made-man. Perhaps God the Father is asking each of us to use this time of social distancing during the Christmas seasons as a moment of intimacy with Him.

Consider those first precious moments when Mary and Joseph were alone with Jesus. Let us use their example as a model for our own intimacy with the Lord ...

... A moment of *amazement* at the mystery of the incarnation.

... A moment of *silence* as we contemplate the great plan of God in our lives.

... A moment of intimacy as we hold the God-made-man close to our hearts.

"O little town of Bethlehem, how still we see thee lie" May the stillness of Bethlehem be the same stillness you experience in your own home this Christmas.

Gospel Meditation

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

December 13, 2020

3rd Sunday of Advent

Gospel: John 1:6-8, 19-28

Did you ever stop and realize that there is no earthly gain that can ever really satisfy us? Think of winning the Lotto. On this side of the winning ticket, it's all about the money, the new car, house, vacations, bank accounts, and infinite pleasures. The possibility of acquiring all of these earthly securities brings us back again and again to the purchase of a ticket. Then, one day we win! Our dreams are fulfilled, and happiness is on the horizon. Then one day, we wake up and realize that nothing has really changed, and I am not as satisfied as I thought I was or would be. I find myself living in my incompleteness and with my profound sorrow and grief. I did not find joy.

Glimpses of joy are possible but not by material means. They are brought to us through incredible experiences of connection that bring us face to face with real and authentic faith, hope, and love. And, they are glimpses and do not last. The moment we find ourselves looking back at them, they are gone, and we find ourselves remembering the moment in memory. To carry joy within us is to realize that it is not something I create, manufacture or even acquire. It is not able to be purchased. It is a gift. My need for joy mirrors my need for eternity, for a Creator who has a claim on the very essence of who I am and desires a home within me. As C. S. Lewis discovered, joy is a surprise that speaks to my very soul and is given as gift by the God who loves me.

The beauty of Advent is found in discovering the beauty of the gift of joy. God has visited his people for no other reason than to show them where and how to find joy! All of our human and earthly joy experiences are always only glimpses. They never satisfy us, sustain us or fulfill us. It is only God who is the joy of my soul. Real, Divine experiences of joy catch us off guard, make us stop and become aware, bring a feeling of awe and rightness and have an eternal Otherness about them. Nothing created by humans can ever come close to this. We probably will not fully realize the truth of all of this until we actually meet God face to face in heaven one day. Then, in that sacred moment when our hearts leap for joy we will understand what we have been tirelessly searching for all along. Intense gratitude will most surely follow. ©LPi






