My big brother, Fr. David, taught me a lot in my life, sometimes in ways I didn't want to be taught. My big brother, Fr. David, taught me how to play sports. He was a baseball player when he was younger. And when he got into high school, he was a wrestler. You know *how* I know he wrestled? Because he practiced on his little brother Fr. Jarrod when he would come home.

My big brother taught me how to work hard. My big brother would do his homework, he would get good grades, and he went to Pittsburg State before he graduated from KU. He got a degree in English. He was able to graduate because of hard work, and he *definitely* worked hard in the seminary.

My big brother taught me how to be prayerful. I remember, one day, coming home after my big brother had knee surgery. His leg was bound up in a big cast. We had a porch out back, and I remember seeing him sitting there on the porch, with a book in his lap, being very deep in thought. I don't know if that's when he felt a call to the priesthood, but I do know that it was soon after I saw him doing that that he told the family that he wanted to become a priest.

My big brother taught me how to listen to the voice of God, so that I could hear the voice of God calling me to be a priest, too.

My big brother was prayerful, was diligent, and was playful. And my big brother's middle name is Joseph. David *Joseph* Lies. He is named after my father, who is David Joseph Lies, Sr.

And today we celebrate St. Joseph, the foster father of Jesus. We specifically pray about St. Joseph the Worker. Just like my big brother taught me how to be prayerful, playful, and faithful, St. Joseph taught Jesus how to be prayerful, playful, and faithful.

St. Joseph was a hard worker. Just like my brother who studied hard and put his effort into education, St. Joseph worked to provide for Jesus and for Mary. St. Joseph, like my brother who was on the back porch thinking deeply about the Holy Spirit, thought deeply about the Holy Spirit and was given the courage to stay with Mary, even though there would be challenges with that, so that he could become the foster father of Jesus.

And because St. Joseph was a hard worker, because he was a faithful man, he also knew how to be a good father to Jesus, even raising him as a child in his own home. St. Joseph even knew how to be playful with Jesus in his own home.

My big brother taught me a lot of things. And your big brothers might be teaching you a lot of things. But whatever they teach you, may they teach you

things like my big brother taught me: how to be prayerful, how to be playful, how to be faithful, and how to be a hard worker, just like St. Joseph, the foster father of Jesus.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Christ Is Anything but Ordinary

We're about to dive headlong into week two of Ordinary Time, and we need to admit, after the hustle and bustle of the holidays, things are indeed looking more ... ordinary, at least in our spiritual lives. The transcendent highs of the Christmas season are flatlining a bit and the vivid imagery of the Nativity scene has faded. Are you bored yet?

Here's a secret: Ordinary Time can be quite extraordinary if we're really living out our baptismal call. In today's Gospel, Jesus asks Andrew, who is following him after hearing John the Baptist's testimony: "What are you looking for?" He's asking us the same question.

What are you looking for? Is it for the Christmas cookies and carols? Is it for the feeling we get on Christmas when we just know God has done a wondrous thing?

None of those things are bad, but they are not what Andrew was looking for, and they were not what Christ promised him when he said, "Come, and you will see." Andrew was looking for the Messiah — the One who makes even Ordinary Time extraordinary. The One who can sanctify the longest and dullest of to-do lists, on the longest and dullest of days. January 17, 2021; Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Gospel: Jn 1:35-42

Our faith is not just about ideas. It's really about having an encounter with God and, in particular, the Risen Christ! Once we give ourselves over to the notion of God's presence, we have to train ourselves to listen for God's voice and be attentive to God's call. Having companions on our faith journeys is so incredibly important as they can help us fine-tune our listening skills and discern God's voice from others we may be hearing. Faith is all about having these profound encounters not only with God but with our brothers and sisters, and creation itself. Anyone or anything that is alive with God's presence becomes an occasion for God to speak and call us to deeper graces and experiences. "Come, and you will see."

The example and teaching of Jesus, the lives of the saints, those living among us and those glorified in heaven, and the wonder and beauty of creation can all serve to help us listen more clearly and assist in positioning ourselves for this profound God meeting. It is an encounter that can quickly and easily lead to a friendship and intimate intertwining of our souls to their Maker, making a claim on us like no other. Then, the Word of God moves from being just a body of ideas to something we simply accept and do. The person of Jesus Christ swiftly moves from being just a good prophet in word and deed to the incarnate presence of God Himself, the Lamb of God. The voice leads us to the Person behind it.

The Gospel is hard to follow. We can intellectually debate whether what Jesus said is really what we are asked to do. The Gospel ideas do not always make sense in our practical, secular world. The person of God always does. We can debate the practicality and sense of ideas and doing so often keeps the more difficult ones at a safe distance away from us. Jesus said to love our enemy, but we really don't need to do that, our minds try to convince us. It just doesn't make sense. Yet, if we are truly in love with the God who is behind the voice of those words, they make perfect sense. Our deep and intimate love of this God would even find us laying down our lives for Him if necessary. Speak Lord, your servant is listening. ©LPi




