SACRAMENTS

Baptisms: Saturdays after 6:00 p.m. evening prayer; Sundays after 1:00 p.m. Mass. Schedule with the church office.

Matrimony: Call a priest 9 months prior to desired wedding date.

Evangelization: We start our days in prayer, end them in thanksgiving, and attend daily Mass together often. SFA students and teachers spend time with Christ during monthly classroom adoration.

Discipleship: Discipleship is evidenced by the commitment of our faculty and staff to their faith, which they in turn pass on to their students. Our older students model discipleship for peers in day-to-day encounters and by serving as "buddies" or mentors for younger students.

Stewardship: At St. Francis, students learn how to live the stewardship way of life by offering prayers, sacrifices, talents, and money in their First Friday Envelopes.

Vocations: Perhaps there is no greater witness to St. Francis' faith formation than the many vocations that have come from our school.

Children's Adoration: St. Francis celebrated its 20th year of children's Eucharistic adoration this year. From the time they are three years old, our students are taught to pray in front of the living God. Through monthly adoration, students and teachers encounter Christ powerfully.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd: We implemented Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS), which fosters the spiritual lives of 500 students and parish children weekly. CGS one of the most important venues in forming disciples. It is a formation in contemplative thinking and deep relationship with Jesus.

Affirmations: In 2018, St. Francis adopted the Capturing Kids' Hearts (CKH) program, meant to develop healthy relationships between members of a school community. Affirmations—written or spoken words of love—are foundational to CKH. These affirmations are written from parent to child, staff to staff, student to student, teacher to student, teacher to parent, and student to teacher and elevate the atmosphere of joy in our school.

Service: Service is exemplified in our annual service day, buddy classes, the eighth-graders' donations to the Sedgwick County Jail's library, fifth graders' letters to parishioners who have lost loved ones and visits to the Kansas Food Bank and the Lord's Diner. For over a decade, we have served the most severely handicapped students in our area at Levy Special Education Center with annual an Skating Day and field day for Levy students. We also take up collections and work on service projects for organizations like Walk in Sister's Shoes, Compassion Without Borders, through which we support the Diocese of Khammam, India, and more.

Daily Prayer: We believe that "prayer without ceasing" fulfills our mission to form saints and encounter the risen Christ! We begin each day with the Morning Offering, pray throughout the day, and end with the Act of Contrition. Teachers begin class in prayer. Middle school students learn how to practice different types of prayer and why prayer is important.

Staff Spiritual Formation: We identify the faith formation needs of faculty and staff through the outreach of our Spirituality Committee, peer discussion, and

small discussion groups. Resources and devotions, including morning Liturgy of the Hours and after-school Learning Through Lent activities, encourage spiritual growth.

We have a wonderful school that is truly Catholic in its culture! If you know of a fellow parishioner that would like to have a Catholic education for their children, please encourage them to contact the school for more information.

ST. JOSEPH VIRTUE OF THE MONTH: February

Prayerful & Contemplative | Pillar of Family Life; Light of Patriarchs
Joseph is the light of patriarchs because he is the most sublime of all fathers. He was a secure anchor, a beacon of light. All this because he was a man of deep prayer and contemplation. Openness and sensitivity to God's Spirit comes only with prolonged fidelity to prayer. How else could his actions speak "fiat" following angelic visits in dreams? How else to trust that he, a simple carpenter, could raise a King? His actions reveal his strong relationship with God. His life of prayer enabled Joseph to let the paternal light of God shine through his own fatherhood, and to be a steadfast support for Mary and Jesus. 

5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Gospel: Mk 1:29-39

If I only knew then what I know now, how different life would be. This sentiment, expressed in myriad ways, is found on every human being's lips at one point or another. Life may have brought us to a vulnerable place where we see some of the poor choices we made and the effects they are having. Perhaps we fell into some destructive and dysfunctional relationships or behaviors and are finding how they held us captive. Our zeal and passion for life may have drifted away and we are waking up to the reasons apathy has taken hold. Life can be hard. In fact, some would describe their lives as a drudgery. They walk through each day with an anxious unsettledness, wondering when their restlessness will cease. There is a temptation to believe that what I see is all I will get. Mortality and hopelessness await the dawn. If I could only have known what would come in the future, I could have made better choices and avoided all of this misery!

Really? While we can certainly give into weakness, sin, impulsiveness, and idiosyncrasies that cause us to stumble over ourselves, life is really a journey. If we don't make the mistake of wallowing in the mire of self-pity and realize the new life God is calling us to, then there are thrills, adventures, surprises, and soul-searching graces we can surely miss. We are not tethered to our past nor are we bound to the ills life can bring upon us. We are never hopeless or helpless. The problem is that our myopic vision only allows us to see the misery and misfortune that is before us, not the potential that can come from choosing healthier and more life-giving options. Jesus came that we might have fullness of life. We need to learn how to reach for Jesus' hand and let him help us to our feet.

We need to allow God into our pain and heal our past. We have to wrestle with our histories, agonize and search and cry out for the Divine healing we need to restore our faith, hope, and love. Job could not see how his story would end or trust the guidance of the God who called him. We live in that same blindness and suffer from the same lack of confidence. Once we allow ourselves to be touched by God's healing power, we begin to see that all of the pieces of our lives are necessary parts of a greater whole. Along the way of our lives, God uses our omissions and failures to create new things and possibilities. When doors close, others open and we can be amazed by the joyful and unexpected surprises we receive. Once we know the power of God's creative, healing, life-giving, forgiving, and dynamic presence, it is no wonder we want to put ourselves at the service of others and show them what life can be. *LPi*


