LOS DOS PADRES Y EL ESTUDIANTE DEBEN ASISTIR

REFLECTION FROM FATHER HAYDEN

“He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them...And Jesus advanced in wisdom and age and favor before God and man.” Pope Paul VI called Nazareth the “school of the Gospel” where “we begin to understand the life of Jesus.” Here, at Nazareth, where Jesus spent the majority of His life in hidden, humble labor and life with his family, He offers us various lessons.

First, the lesson of silence: “O silence of Nazareth, teach us recollection, reflection, and eagerness to heed the good inspirations and words of true teachers; teach us the need and value of preparation, of study, of meditation, of interior life, of secret prayer seen by God alone.” Next, the lesson of domestic life: “may Nazareth teach us the meaning of family life, its harmony of love, its simplicity and austere beauty, its sacred and inviolable character; may it teach us how sweet and irreplaceable is its training, how fundamental and incomparable its role on the social plane.” Finally, the lesson of work: “O Nazareth, home of the carpenter’s son, We want here to understand and to praise the austere and redeeming law of human labor, here to restore the consciousness of the dignity of labor, here to recall that work cannot be an end in itself, and that it is free and ennobling in proportion to the values – beyond the economic ones – which motivate it.”

On this Sunday of the Holy Family, we pray that our homes may become more like Nazareth. We pray that we will learn, with Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, the lessons of silence, domestic life, and work. We pray that our homes, too, will become schools of the Gospel, after the example of the hidden, humble life of the Holy Family at Nazareth.

STEWARDSHIP

My Father’s House

Sir 3:2-6, 12-14/ Col 3:12-21/ Lk 2:41-52

Notice the slight shift created in today’s Gospel, stemming from the use of one capital letter. We can only imagine the fear and frustration Mary must have felt when she finally found Jesus after being separated from Him for three days. She says: “Your father and I have been looking for you with great anxiety.” The 12-year-old Jesus responds with: “Did you not know that I must be in my Father’s house?” The slight shift from *father* to *Father* speaks volumes here. Jesus acknowledges Joseph and Mary as His earthly parents, and He is obedient to them. However, He seems quite aware that He is not “of this world” and must make His way to His Father’s house. May we all remember that we should not allow ourselves to get lost or attached to things in this world and that we should, instead, make our way to our Father’s house. Like the child Jesus, we are called to obedience in this temporary world, but we were created for holiness in the Kingdom of God!

REFLEXION DEL PADRE HAYDEN

“Entonces volvió con ellos a Nazaret y siguió sujeto a su autoridad... Jesús iba creciendo en saber, en estatura y en el favor de Dios y de los hombres”. El Papa Pablo VI llamó a Nazaret la “escuela del Evangelio” donde “comenzamos a comprender la vida de Jesús”. Aquí, en Nazaret, donde Jesús pasó la mayor parte de su vida en un trabajo y una vida humildes y ocultos con su familia, nos ofrece varias lecciones.

Primero, la lección del silencio: “Oh silencio de Nazaret, enséñanos el recogimiento, la reflexión y el afán de escuchar las buenas inspiraciones y palabras de verdaderos maestros; enséñanos la necesidad y el valor de la preparación, del estudio, de la meditación, de la vida interior, de la oración secreta vista solo por Dios”. A continuación, la lección de la vida doméstica: “que Nazaret nos enseñe el sentido de la vida familiar, su armonía de amor, su sencillez y austera belleza, su carácter sagrado e inviolable; Que enseñe es cuán dulce e insustituible es su formación, cuán fundamental e incomparable su papel en el plano social”. Finalmente, la lección del trabajo: “Oh Nazaret, hogar del hijo del carpintero, Queremos aquí comprender y alabar la ley austera y redentora del trabajo humano, aquí para restaurar la conciencia de la dignidad del trabajo, aquí para recordar ese trabajo no puede ser un fin en sí mismo, y que es libre y ennoblecedor en proporción a los valores -más allá de los económicos- que lo motivan”.

En este domingo de la Sagrada Familia, rezamos para que nuestros hogares se parezcan más a Nazaret. Oramos para que aprendamos, con Jesús, María y José, las lecciones del silencio, la vida doméstica y el trabajo. Oramos para que nuestros hogares también se conviertan en escuelas del Evangelio, siguiendo el ejemplo de la vida oculta y humilde de la Sagrada Familia en Nazaret.

STEWARDSHIP

Casa de mi Padre

Sir 3:2-6, 12-14/ Col 3:12-21/ Lc 2:41-52

Fíjate en el pequeño cambio producido en el Evangelio de hoy, proveniente del uso de una letra mayúscula. Sólo podemos imaginar el miedo y la frustración que María seguramente sentía cuando por fin encontró a Jesús tras pasar tres días separada de él. Le dice: “Hijo mío, ¿por qué te has portado así con nosotros? Tu padre y yo te hemos estado buscando llenos de angustia”. El niño Jesús de 12 años responde: “¿No sabían que debo ocuparme en las cosas de mi Padre?” El pequeño cambio de *padre* a *Padre* en esta frase tiene importancia. Jesús reconoce a José y María como sus padres terrenales, y es obediente con ellos. Sin embargo, parece muy consciente de que no es “de este mundo” y que tiene que dirigirse a la casa de su Padre. Todos tenemos que recordar que no deberíamos perdernos ni apegarnos a las cosas de este mundo y que, al contrario, deberíamos dirigirnos a la casa de nuestro Padre. Como el niño Jesús, estamos llamados a la obediencia en este mundo temporal, pero fuimos creados para la santidad en el Reino de Dios.
