**Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:**



**FAITH:** As people of faith and reason, Catholics are called to bring truth to political life. Faith helps us see more clearly the requirements of a good society, namely respect for the dignity of all human life and a commitment to the common good.

**CONSCIENCE:** A well-formed conscience equips us to address political questions. "Conscience is a judgment of reason whereby the human person recognizes the moral quality of a concrete act. . . . [Every person] is obliged to follow faithfully what he [or she] knows to be just and right" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1778*). We have a lifelong obligation to form our consciences in accord with human reason, enlightened by the teaching of Christ as it comes to us through the Church. Catholics should consult the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* and the *Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church* to form their consciences according to Catholic teaching.

**ISSUES:** Some issues concern policies, like attacks on human life, that a Catholic can never support. Catholics can legitimately disagree about how to address some other issues. All the issues, however, deserve our attention.

**CHOICES:** Find out the candidates' positions on each of the issues. Look beyond party politics, analyze campaign rhetoric critically, consider the character and integrity of the candidate, and choose political leaders according to the principles of your faith. Turn to God in prayer asking for guidance. To find out who is running for office in your area and where to vote, contact the Secretary of State at <https://www.sos.nd.gov> (800-352-0867).

**VOTE:** Catholics have an obligation to participate in the democratic process. Remember to vote and, no matter what the outcome, become involved in the legislative process. One way to get involved is by joining the *Legislative Action Network*.
