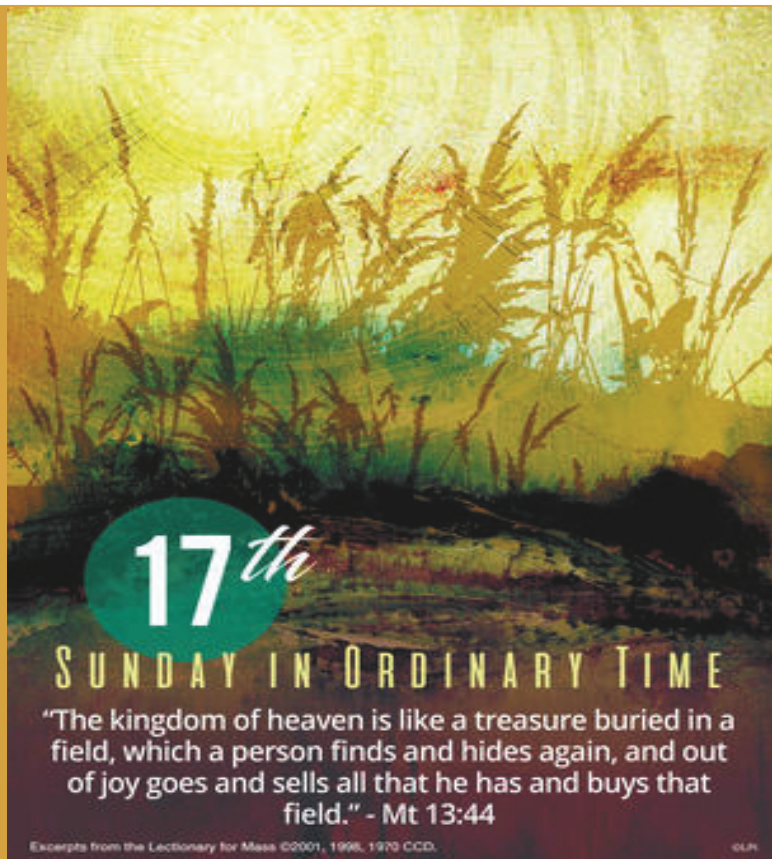

We are inviting the Sacred Heart family and others across the Province to join in the reading of one of 3 books that our Associate Leadership Team has chosen. It is our next step in our work towards creating a more just world. We begin with ourselves.

We will host a Zoom Discussion Session on Sunday, September 13, 2020, at 5:30 PM Eastern Time and will put you in a breakout room for the book you have chosen.

1. The three book options are -

- ***Between the World and Me*** by Ta-Nehisi Coates This is a poignant, poetic, and hard-hitting experiential account of what it is like to inhabit a black body in the US, and told through a series of letters to his son.
- ***White Fragility*** by Dr. Robin DiAngelo This is an eye-opening analysis of how White People often unwittingly get in the way of meaningful cross-racial dialogue because of their own unexamined tangle of emotions, leading to behaviors that serve to protect or reinstate racial inequality. And this book shows us how white people can engage more constructively.
- ***No Crystal Stair: Womanist Theology*** by Dr. Diana L. Hayes This book is a collection of essays, prayers, and meditations, rooted in the lived faith and struggles of African-American women. The author is an esteemed African-American professor and theologian, and one of the thought leaders on Womanist theology. This third choice grows out of our belief that it is important to broaden our own spiritual and theological inputs and listen to read voices in our own Catholic tradition that may have been marginalized.

## The Stations of the Cross Reopening

The Stations of the Cross at *The Cloisters on the Platte* will reopen to the public beginning **Monday, August 3rd**. Precautions will be taken to implement social distancing and to sanitize audio equipment and indoor areas to prevent spreading COVID-19. Plan to wear a mask for your shuttle ride and gift shop visit.

Experience the 2,500 foot long walking tour of **The Stations of the Cross**, comprised of 14 sculptures depicting Christ's trial through his burial. Visitors are encouraged to donate \$10 or more per person. With each donation, visitors will receive a complimentary audio tour.

**The new expanded visiting hours are Monday through Thursday 9am to 4pm; Friday and Saturday 9am to 3pm.** Visitors may remain at the Stations of the Cross for up to an hour after closing time. 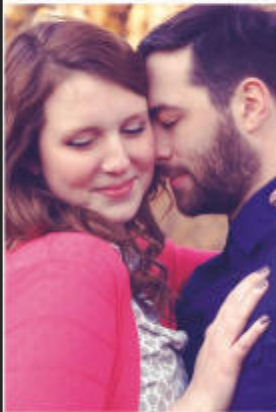
