- We ask all of this confident in your Spirit. Amen



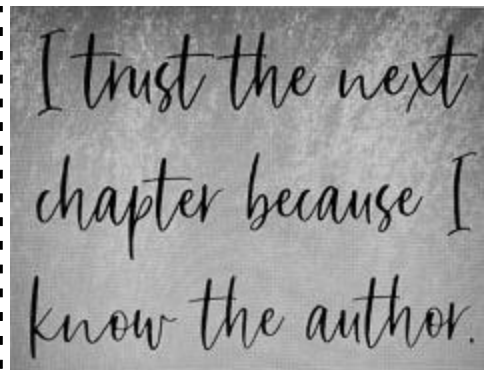

Racism is sinful and harmful to your creation. Guard our hearts against it, and move us forward to enact

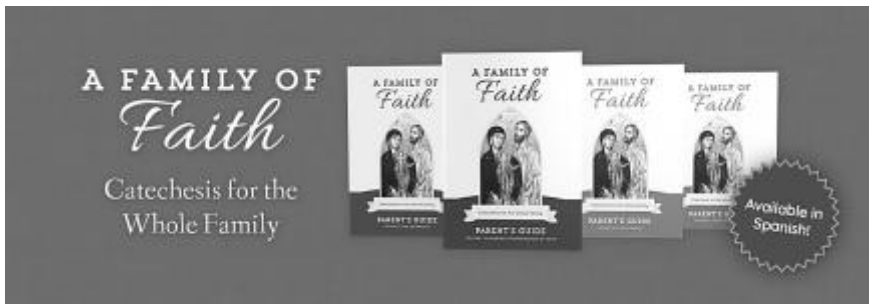

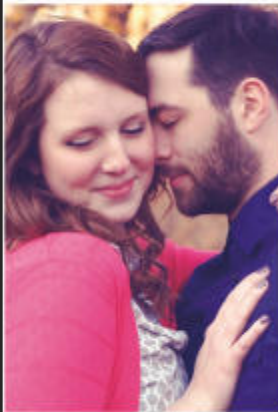
