Save the Earth through Composting

The parish office building now has a compost bin, located on the southwest corner of the building. Parishioners wishing to bring their compostable items to church are now free to use this bin.

The following items can be composted: Fruits, vegetables, dairy, meat, bone, fat, shells, bread, juice, coffee grounds, eggshells and anything food related. Non recyclable paper paper towels, napkins, coffee filters, teabags, compostable service ware, BPI, 7PLA, or certified compostable cups plates and utensils.



“**Bike with Mike**”, an event to raise awareness and resources for mental health in the Omaha community will take place **Saturday June 5th** Mike Kutilek developed mental illness in his late 20’s and passed away in May of 2020, and the Kutilek family has organized this event in Mike’s honor. The event is a bike ride / walk on the Wabash Trace from Lewis Central Jr. High in Council Bluffs to Mineola, Iowa (the famous “Taco Ride”). The ride / walk will begin around 10 am, and about 10 miles down the trail in Mineola. We will stop for tacos and a brief program around noon at Toby Jack’s restaurant before returning. Participants can also simply drive directly to Mineola for the lunch and program. All proceeds for this event will directly support the integrated community mental health services provided by **Community Alliance of Omaha**.

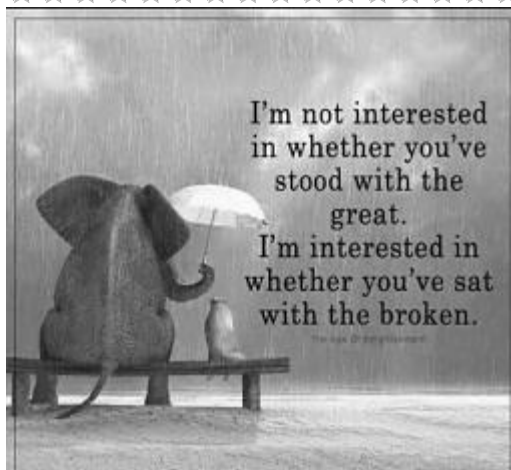
