Save the Earth through Composting

The parish office building now has a compost bin, located on the southwest corner of the building. Parishioners wishing to bring their compostable items to church are now free to use this bin.

The following items can be composted: Fruits, vegetables, dairy, meat, bone, fat, shells, bread, juice, coffee grounds, eggshells and anything food related. Non recyclable paper paper towels, napkins, coffee filters, teabags, compostable service ware, BPI, 7PLA, or certified compostable cups, plates and utensils.
