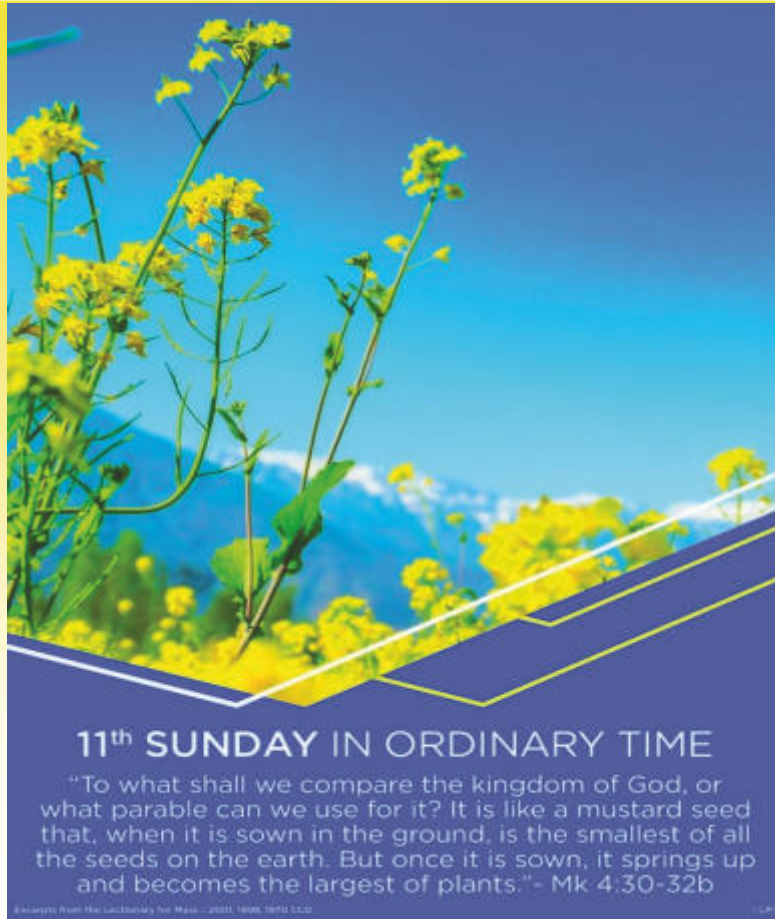

The Nomination of Barbara Lutey for the 2021 Pillar Award

The recipient of the Pillar Award is someone who is reliable and supportive, helping to hold up the structure of our Sacred Heart Parish. Like most pillars of a building structure, sometimes you notice and are even in awe of the outward beauty of them, and then take time to ponder how they are built, but you truly don't really appreciate their purposeful strength until a violent

storm blows in. Barbara's faith-filled example and love of the Eucharist has proven to be so sturdy and rock solid for our parish, especially withstanding the storm and unknown trepidations of the COVID-19 pandemic.

She was one of the first handful of people who participated in daily Mass via Facebook and learning that new normal of being muted or not muted! She was one of the speakers for the Chapel Chat Series; her words gave hope and helped us stay spiritually connected as we were isolated in our homes. She valiantly lead the Seeking Truth Bible Study and the Seven Secrets of the Eucharist prayer group via Zoom with such grace. She spearheaded our Eucharistic Adoration available at Sacred heart She is our local anchoress for the Seven Sisters apostolate, a year-long group committed to one holy hour each week to pray for the sanctity of our priests. When I see Barbara, I feel a sense of security, joy and gratitude. she influences me to learn more about the wisdom and truth of our faith and to be mindful of my own wrongdoings...to be the best servant of our Lord as possible. 2021 Nomination of Matt Holland for the Denny Holland Award

Matt Holland has done a wonderful job of working with the Social Justice committee at Sacred Heart Church. He has enhanced the connection between the church and the community by sponsoring events at North Omaha Art Galleries and the Great Plains Black History Museum. A few weeks back, our parish was challenged to rise up and pray for an end to violence in North Omaha. We were asked to "fast" from violence to show

care and concern for our neighbors. Matt Holland was there showing his support. In his quiet and gentle way, Matt is a bridge builder and a friend to all. Matt is also an historian. He has researched the Omaha DePorres Club and it's profound impact on Civil Rights in Omaha. He wrote a book, "Ahead of their Time" documenting the work of the DePorres Club and led an 8 week book study at Sacred Heart during the pandemic. Matt's parents were active in this group and he follows in the beautiful legacy of Denny and Jean Holland. He heads up the Neighborhood Alliance Committee here at Sacred Heart and worked on the Reconciliation Service with St. Benedict the Moor Parish and is really helping us to build bridges with our neighbors.

We are grateful to Matt and want to congratulate him on receiving the 2021 Denny Holland Award!
