## BAPTISM

**Celebrated on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays of the month.** Preparatory session for parents is required prior to scheduling the baptism. Please call the rectory for additional information.

**FIRST RECONCILIATION, FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION**  
The Religious Education program prepares learners for First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation with cooperation from parents and catechists. To participate, please register with the Religious Education office by mid-August. Preparation and celebration of First Reconciliation and First Communion ordinarily takes place in second grade. At St. Mary's, Confirmation is a two-year process involving students in grades 7 and 8. The Religious Education program and Parish School celebrate reception of each of these sacraments jointly. Because sacraments are celebrated as a parish, all participants in Sacramental Preparation must be registered members of the parish.

## MARRIAGE

According to Archdiocese regulations, a date for a wedding must be arranged **at least** six months prior to the wedding. Call the church **FIRST**, before you schedule a reception venue! Contact the rectory with any questions.

### CENTENNIAL CORNER

Happy Valentine's Day from the centennial committee! The love you have for St. Mary's has been seen through your many stories and photos this past year. Enjoy a few February articles found in local papers at the Sarpy County Museum:

- \* In celebration of St. Valentine's Day, the St. Mary's Guild presented a wedding gown fashion show entitled "Sweethearts of Old Lace" with gowns ranging from an 1879 model originally worn by Mrs. Charles Butler Edmunds and modeled by her great granddaughter, Maureen Duffy." February 1972
- \* Members of St. Mary's Girl Scout Troop 439 entertained their mothers at a Valentine Tea February 13, 1969 at the Bank of Bellevue. *Anyone remember this?*
- \* St. Mary's Youth Group had a skating party on February 18, 1968 at the Ak-Sar-Ben ice rink.
- \* Lent starts this week. Fifty-three years ago in 1968 a 7:30 Wednesday evening Mass was added during Lent. Also, "The Way of the Cross" was said on Friday evenings.
- \* Sixty-two years ago on Monday, February 15, 1959, the new rectory was blessed by Archbishop Gerald T. Bergan. It would provide quarters for Fr. Garvey and Fr. Anthony Milone. Archbishop Bergan also confirmed "a class of 150 while in Bellevue".

Those who order a centennial brick should receive an order confirmation email to ensure accurate inscriptions some time in March prior to the final engraving process by Endicott Brick Co., Endicott, Nebraska.

The replicated "Our Lady of the Runways" medals have arrived! Unlike the original medal, the full words "Our Lady of the Runways" are inscribed. The medals are now on the rosaries displayed at church. Thanks to Frans Lang who is putting the medals onto our rosaries. The new rosary colors are online and in the display case on the centennial table. Colors are limited so order soon! *The price of a full decade rosary is \$20 and a single decade is \$10. Checks, made payable to St. Mary's, or cash may be sent to the rectory. Once payment has been received, rosaries will be available at church after Masses or they can be picked up at the rectory. ## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Our Community Gathering will change this month due to Ash Wednesday. **We will offer Ash Wednesday Mass on February 17th at 5:00 p.m. and again at 7:00 p.m. for our Community Gathering. Please note the change of time.**

**First Reconciliation** will be offered one of three ways this year due to COVID restrictions.

- Your child may attend a communal Reconciliation.
- Your child may attend a regularly scheduled Reconciliation held on Tuesdays from 5:00-5:30 p.m. or Saturdays from 3:30-4:45 p.m. in the church Reconciliation Room.
- Your child may attend Reconciliation with one of our priests by appointment.

Once your child has decided how to receive their First Reconciliation, please contact the RE office to either RSVP for the communal Reconciliation or forward the date for individual Reconciliation for their certificate and for church records.

First Reconciliation practice presented by Fr. Del Lape will be held on March 7th from 1:00-2:00 p.m. in parish center. RE families are required to attend.

The First Reconciliation Communal Rite will be held April 17th at 10:30 a.m. in the church. This is one of the options for your children to attend their First Reconciliation.

**First Communion** introduction meeting on March 7th from 2:00-3:00 p.m. Fr. Del will be hosting the meeting either in person at the parish center or through Zoom. You must RSVP to [etomaso@stmarysbelleveue.com](mailto:etomaso@stmarysbelleveue.com).

First Communion practice will be held at 9:15 a.m. in the church the Saturday before your child's scheduled First Communion. This practice is required for those who will receive Communion for the first time spring 2021. Schedule your child's First Communion any Sunday during the month of May that will meet your family's needs. Due to limited space, there will be a limit of **8 First Communion families per Mass** and families may only invite up to **6** guests. You must RSVP to [etomaso@stmarysbelleveue.com](mailto:etomaso@stmarysbelleveue.com) for your Mass selection.

### Confirmation

**7th grade** – The Rite of Entrance is for all 7th grade students preparing for Confirmation in 2022. This will be on February 27th at the 5:00 p.m. Mass or on February 28th at the 8:00 or 10:00 a.m. Mass. Students and their parents or sponsor must check in at the south entrance of church before Mass.

The 7th grade retreat will be a half day at St. Mary's. The date will be announced soon.

**8th grade** – The Rite of Enrollment is for all 8th grade students preparing for Confirmation in 2021. This will be held on April 17th at the 5:00 p.m. Mass or April 18th at the 8:00 or 10:00 a.m. Mass. Students and their parents or sponsor must check in at the south entrance of the church.

The 8th grade retreat will be a half day at St. Mary's. The date will be announced soon. Confirmation Reflection and Rehearsal will be on April 30th. The Reflection will start at 5:30 p.m. in the parish center. This is required for all who will be Confirmed in 2021. It is required that the parent or sponsor attend the Rehearsal to be held at 7:00 p.m. the same night in the parish center. Confirmation will be on May 1st at 7:00 p.m. Archbishop Lucas will be the president. **All Confirmation paperwork for 7th and 8th grade is due on April 15th.**
