Mission Statement



BAPTISM

Celebrated on the 2nd & 4th Sundays of the month. Preparatory session for parents is required prior to scheduling the baptism. Please call the rectory for additional information.

FIRST RECONCILIATION, FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION
The Religious Education program prepares learners for First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation with cooperation from parents and catechists. To participate, please register with the Religious Education office by mid-August. Preparation and celebration of First Reconciliation and First Communion ordinarily takes place in second grade. At St. Mary's, Confirmation is a two-year process involving students in grades 7 and 8. The Religious Education program and Parish School celebrate reception of each of these sacraments jointly. Because sacraments are celebrated as a parish, all participants in Sacramental Preparation must be registered members of the parish.

MARRIAGE

According to Archdiocese regulations, a date for a wedding must be arranged **at least** six months prior to the wedding. Call the church **FIRST**, before you schedule a reception venue! Contact the rectory with any questions.

CENTENNIAL CORNER

The centennial committee has been busy reviewing photos, newspaper articles and other centennial related activities such as the upcoming centennial Mass and dinner. We hope you have your calendar marked for April 25, 2021. Formal invitations have been sent to honored guests. Parishioners may make Mass and dinner reservations starting in late March using Sign-Up Genius or by calling the rectory. *Please do not call now.* Thank you.

Centennial brick orders are due the end of February. Order forms are available online or at the centennial table. Mail them to the rectory or drop them off at the centennial table. Those who order a brick should receive an order confirmation email to ensure accurate inscriptions some time in March. The centennial brick pathway will be completed in May.

We welcome pre-orders for the centennial book. We still have centennial t-shirts and sweatshirts, license plate frames, and ball caps for sale. Order forms are online or at the centennial table.

Centennial rosaries are being completed now that the Our Lady of the Runways medals have arrived. The medals are now on the rosaries on display. *Full decade rosaries are \$20; single decade rosaries are \$10.* Checks, made payable to St. Mary's Church, or cash may be sent to the rectory or placed in the centennial box on the centennial table by the south entrance doorway. Once payment has been received, rosaries will be available at church after weekend Masses or they can be picked up at the rectory. If possible, they will be blessed before distribution. Some past February events we've discovered through old Bellevue papers include:

- St. Mary's Cadet team took Class B League and Tournament trophies on Saturday, February 24, 1973. *Does anyone know why they were called the Cadets and not the Spartans?*
- St. Mary's School had a skating party at Skateland on February 18, 1980 to raise funds for charity. They decided to donate funds raised to the Brinker family who had a fire in January of that year and to two teachers: Sr. Regina Marie and Sr. Claire Marie.
- A paper reported on February 23, 1974 that the school had a paper drive with a goal of 10,000 tons in connection with Keep Omaha Beautiful.
- That same paper of February 23, 1974 pictured seventh and eighth graders, Jane Carnazzo and Mary Ellen Vacek, observing two dozen chicken eggs in incubation at school.

Sr. Joan Miriam Glaser, one of the three 1948 Dominican Sisters, recently called to wish St. Mary's a wonderful centennial celebration. She is from Nebraska; her cousin is Margaret McQuade of St. Mary's. At almost 95 years young, she is in good health except for some dizziness issues. Please keep her in your prayers. *We welcome your memories of the Sisters, lay teachers, coaches and classmates.*

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

First Reconciliation will be offered one of three ways this year due to COVID restrictions.

- Your child may attend a communal Reconciliation.
- Your child may attend a regularly scheduled Reconciliation held on Tuesdays from 5:00-5:30 p.m. or Saturdays from 3:30-4:45 p.m. in the church Reconciliation Room.
- Your child may attend Reconciliation with one of our priests by appointment.

Once your child has decided how to receive their First Reconciliation, please contact the RE office to either RSVP for the communal Reconciliation or forward the date for individual Reconciliation for their certificate and for church records.

First Reconciliation practice presented by Fr. Del Lape will be held on March 7th from 1:00-2:00 p.m. in parish center. RE families are required to attend.

The First Reconciliation Communal Rite will be held April 17th at 10:30 a.m. in the church. This is one of the options for your children to attend their First Reconciliation.

First Communion introduction meeting on March 7th from 2:00-3:00 p.m. Fr. Del will be hosting the meeting either in person at the parish center or through Zoom. You must RSVP to etomaso@stmarysbellevue.com.

First Communion practice will be held at 9:15 a.m. in the church the Saturday before your child's scheduled First Communion. This practice is required for those who will receive Communion for the first time spring 2021. Schedule your child's First Communion any Sunday during the month of May that will meet your family's needs. Due to limited space, there will be a limit of **8 First Communion families per Mass** and families may only invite up to **6** guests. You must RSVP to etomaso@stmarysbellevue.com for your Mass selection.

Confirmation

7th grade – The Rite of Entrance is for all 7th grade students preparing for Confirmation in 2022. **This will be on February 27th at the 5:00 p.m. Mass or on February 28st at the 10:00 a.m. Mass.** Students and their parents or sponsor must check in at the south entrance of church before Mass.

The 7th grade retreat will be a half day at St. Mary's. The date will be announced soon.

8th grade – The Rite of Enrollment is for all 8th grade students preparing for Confirmation in 2021. This will be held on April 17th at the 5:00 p.m. Mass or April 18th at the 8:00 or 10:00 a.m. Mass. Students and their parents or sponsor must check in at the south entrance of the church.

The 8th grade retreat will be a half day at St. Mary's. The date will be announced soon. Confirmation Reflection and Rehearsal will be on April 30th. The Reflection will start at 5:30 p.m. in the parish center. This is required for all who will be Confirmed in 2021. It is required that the parent or sponsor attend the Rehearsal at 7:00 p.m. the same night in the parish center.

The 8th grade retreat will be a half day at St. Mary's. The date will be announced soon. Confirmation Reflection and Rehearsal will be on April 30th. The Reflection will start at 5:30 p.m. in the parish center. This is required for all who will be Confirmed in 2021. It is required that the parent or sponsor attend the Rehearsal at 7:00 p.m. the same night in the parish center.

Confirmation will be on May 1st at 7:00 p.m. Archbishop Lucas will be the presider. **All Confirmation paperwork for 7th and 8th grade is due on April 15th.**
