FIRST RECONCILIATION, FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION
The Religious Education program prepares learners for First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation with cooperation from parents and catechists. To participate, please register with the Religious Education office by mid-August. Preparation and celebration of First Reconciliation and First Communion ordinarily takes place in second grade. At St. Mary's, Confirmation is a two-year process involving students in grades 7 and 8. The Religious Education program and Parish School celebrate reception of each of these sacraments jointly. Because sacraments are celebrated as a parish, all participants in Sacramental Preparation must be registered members of the parish.

MARRIAGE

According to Archdiocese regulations, a date for a wedding must be arranged **at least** six months prior to the wedding. Call the church **FIRST**, before you schedule a reception venue! Contact the rectory with any questions.

The centennial committee is looking for some answers. *When was Mary Margaret Burdick choir director? Who were choir directors in the 60's and 70's? Anne Kouba played the organ in the choir loft of the original church. Who was in the choir? Does anyone have memories of parish picnics held at the base lake? Who knows about the metal Mary statue on the north side of church? When did she arrive? Did someone donate that Mary statue? We found religious education slides taken in the 80's. Anyone know who might have taken those?*

Looking back in time this week:

- "Some 150 attended the banquet including mothers, fathers and sons." It was held in the gym at St. Mary's School." *March 6, 1958*
- St. Mary's Home and School Association annual luncheon and card party is set for March 27 beginning at noon. Tickets are \$2.50 and will be available at the door. *March 1, 1980*
- The parish Advisory Council finished its first year of operation. Officers: President Dale McCarty; Joe Philbin, vice-president; Pauline Marchio, secretary-treasurer. *March 7, 1968*
- "Members of St. Mary's Youth Group are reminded to attend some of the guitar Masses as a Lenten observance. The Masses are Tuesday evenings at 7:30." *March 7, 1968*
- March Madness sixty-three years ago: "In the finals Sunday afternoon at Cathedral High School gym in Omaha, St. Mary's of Bellevue defeated St. Bernard's of Omaha 15 to 6 to win the Class "C" grade school tournament." *March 3, 1958*
- "The Spartans downed Assumption in the finals of the Class B tournament 55-41 and in doing so gave Coach Rick Carey his 50th victory and added a new trophy to the school's collection." *March 3, 1973*
- "St. Mary's Church is seeking "angels", not the kind with wings but "angels" to back the proposed expansion of St. Mary's School. In a letter to parishioners this week, Fr. Garvey, pastor of the church, said that at least \$20,000 was needed to start construction this June on plans for four additional classrooms, library and principal's office. The total estimated cost of the addition is estimated at \$55,000. The school is already over-crowded with a total of 215 students in the five classrooms, making an average of 43 students to a room. A temporary room was built on the ground floor next to the furnace room last summer". *March 6, 1953*

MARCH RECONCILIATION TIMES

March 2020, we were reeling with the beginning trials and tribulations of Covid 19. We are still dealing with it, but we hope vaccinations will be available for all soon and that this virus is finally gone from our midst. However, we are still taking precautions. With that in mind, we will not have Communal Reconciliation services again this Lent. However, individual confession times will be extended on Tuesdays and Thursdays throughout March 2021.

Tuesdays - 5:00-6:00 p.m.
Thursdays - Noon-1:00 p.m.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

First Reconciliation will be offered one of three ways this year due to COVID restrictions.

- Your child may attend a communal Reconciliation.
- Your child may attend a regularly scheduled Reconciliation held on Tuesdays from 5:00-5:30 p.m. or Saturdays from 3:30-4:45 p.m. in the church Reconciliation Room.
- Your child may attend Reconciliation with one of our priests by appointment.

Once your child has decided how to receive their First Reconciliation, please contact the RE office to either RSVP for the communal Reconciliation or forward the date for individual Reconciliation for their certificate and for church records.

First Reconciliation practice presented by Fr. Del Lape will be held on March 7th from 1:00-2:00 p.m. in parish center. RE families are required to attend.

The First Reconciliation Communal Rite will be held April 17th at 10:30 a.m. in the church. This is one of the options for your children to attend their First Reconciliation.

First Communion introduction meeting on March 7th from 2:00-3:00 p.m. Fr. Del will be hosting the meeting either in person at the parish center or through Zoom. You must RSVP to etomaso@stmarysbelleveue.com.

First Communion practice will be held at 9:15 a.m. in the church the Saturday before your child's scheduled First Communion. This practice is required for those who will receive Communion for the first time spring 2021. Schedule your child's First Communion any Sunday during the month of May that will meet your family's needs. Due to limited space, there will be a limit of **8 First Communion families per Mass** and families may only invite up to **6** guests. You must RSVP to etomaso@stmarysbelleveue.com for your Mass selection.

Confirmation

7th grade – The Rite of Entrance is for all 7th grade students preparing for Confirmation in 2022. **This will be on February 27th at the 5:00 p.m. Mass or on February 28st at the 10:00 a.m. Mass.** Students and their parents or sponsor must check in at the south entrance of church before Mass.

The 7th grade retreat will be a half day at St. Mary's. The date will be announced soon.

8th grade – The Rite of Enrollment is for all 8th grade students preparing for Confirmation in 2021. This will be held on April 17th at the 5:00 p.m. Mass or April 18th at the 8:00 or 10:00 a.m. Mass. Students and their parents or sponsor must check in at the south entrance of the church.

The 8th grade retreat will be a half day at St. Mary's. The date will be announced soon. Confirmation Reflection and Rehearsal will be on April 30th. The Reflection will start at 5:30 p.m. in the parish center. This is required for all who will be Confirmed in 2021. It is required that the parent or sponsor attend the Rehearsal at 7:00 p.m. the same night in the parish center.

The 8th grade retreat will be a half day at St. Mary's. The date will be announced soon. Confirmation Reflection and Rehearsal will be on April 30th. The Reflection will start at 5:30 p.m. in the parish center. This is required for all who will be Confirmed in 2021. It is required that the parent or sponsor attend the Rehearsal at 7:00 p.m. the same night in the parish center.

Confirmation will be on May 1st at 7:00 p.m. Archbishop Lucas will be the presider. **All Confirmation paperwork for 7th and 8th grade is due on April 15th.**

Lenten Rice Bowls for Catholic Relief Services are at the south entrance of church. Please take one home for your family.


