FIRST RECONCILIATION, FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION
The Religious Education program prepares learners for First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation with cooperation from parents and catechists. To participate, please register with the Religious Education office by mid-August. Preparation and celebration of First Reconciliation and First Communion ordinarily takes place in second grade. At St. Mary's, Confirmation is a two-year process involving students in grades 7 and 8. The Religious Education program and Parish School celebrate reception of each of these sacraments jointly. Because sacraments are celebrated as a parish, all participants in Sacramental Preparation must be registered members of the parish.

MARRIAGE

According to Archdiocese regulations, a date for a wedding must be arranged **at least** six months prior to the wedding. Call the church **FIRST**, before you schedule a reception venue! Contact the rectory with any questions.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

Available at the Sunday 10:00 a.m. Mass for all children 4 years old through 4th grade. After the Opening Prayers, a Catechist leads the children down to our parish center where a special homily centered around the Gospel reading is presented. Tidbits of history:

- A June 9, 1971 newspaper article announced the official meeting of Court 2036 of St. Mary's Catholic Daughters which would be held on June 14, 1971 at 8 pm in the Knights of Columbus Hall adjacent to the parking lot. Yes, the Knights Hall was once in St. Mark's Hall.
- Thirty-five years ago, there were two June 11, 1986 newspaper articles about our neighbors "up the hill"- the Columban Fathers. One was entitled "Worldwide Missionary Work Beginning in the Heart of Bellevue". The other article reported on several aspects of the Columban Fathers including the annual Columban festivals at which 400 volunteers work 42 booths. Fr. Edward Dolan called the festival "our window to the world". Father also mentioned that they employed 40 local people to work at the Columbans including some that worked in the overseas direct mail operations for which he was the director. Fr. Dolan was named "Boss of the Year" back then by the "American Business Women's Association". There are parishioners who work there today as did Sylvia Thompson and Connie Wacha years ago. In this same article it also mentioned how the Columban Fathers donated 10 of their 40 acres to Bellewood Courts to provide housing for the elderly through a project financed by the Dept. of Housing and Urban Development. Bellewood Courts is right off Lincoln Road.
