**FIRST RECONCILIATION, FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION**  
The Religious Education program prepares learners for First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation with cooperation from parents and catechists. To participate, please register with the Religious Education office by mid-August. Preparation and celebration of First Reconciliation and First Communion ordinarily takes place in second grade. At St. Mary's, Confirmation is a two-year process involving students in grades 7 and 8. The Religious Education program and Parish School celebrate reception of each of these sacraments jointly. Because sacraments are celebrated as a parish, all participants in Sacramental Preparation must be registered members of the parish.

## MARRIAGE

According to Archdiocese regulations, a date for a wedding must be arranged **at least** six months prior to the wedding. Call the church **FIRST**, before you schedule a reception venue! Contact the rectory with any questions.

## CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

### St. Mary's Centennial Committee

Centennial items are for sale after weekend Masses this weekend but not on July 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>. Shirts that are "out of stock" will be re-ordered. IF you want a shirt in L, XL, 2XL or 3XL or sweatshirts in sizes -adult M, L or XL please let a sales rep know this weekend after Masses so we know for sure who wishes to purchase one. Our second annual centennial golf tournament will be held 1 pm. on Friday Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup> at Tregaron. Price \$80 each/\$320 a foursome. Registration forms are at church this weekend and online soon!

As the book committee searched for our history, we found many wonderful things but discovered one in particular that we almost forgot about: The "vocations cross" located on a stand near the adorer's pew closest to where an altar server sits. In 1989 then Fr. Cupich [now Cardinal Cupich] discussed with parishioner, Henry Morris, about the need for a vocation committee. Henry recruited his wife and several other parishioners to become that committee. One of their goals was to "establish a traveling cross to encourage prayer for vocations". Fr. Jerry Connealy brought the cross from Medjugorje. It was mounted on a base by parishioner Dan Reilly; blessed and presented to St. Mary's on Sept. 24, 1989. It can be taken out of church for one week at a time by anyone, a class or a family. Parishioners at that time and today are encouraged to take it and pray before it for an increase in vocations. With no ordinations this year in the Omaha archdiocese, it might be wise to consider doing so.

Many memories have been submitted for the centennial book. All are a journey back in time.

*A few memories we'd like to share: "One practice that particularly distinguished the Catholic family in those days was the meatless Fridays. This was an ongoing practice not just restricted to Lent. There were also other meatless days such as Christmas Eve." Kevin Duffy*

*"Bill Friend was the custodian from 1960-1975. Bill's duties were cleaning the classrooms, mowing all the church grounds, and snow removal. He was also the repairman when problems occurred in the church, school, rectory or the nun's residence. In the winter he had to make sure he switched the heat over to oil at a strategic certain time." Kay Friend Hoelting*
