FIRST RECONCILIATION, FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION
The Religious Education program prepares learners for First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation with cooperation from parents and catechists. To participate, please register with the Religious Education office by mid-August. Preparation and celebration of First Reconciliation and First Communion ordinarily takes place in second grade. At St. Mary's, Confirmation is a two-year process involving students in grades 7 and 8. The Religious Education program and Parish School celebrate reception of each of these sacraments jointly. Because sacraments are celebrated as a parish, all participants in Sacramental Preparation must be registered members of the parish.

MARRIAGE

According to Archdiocese regulations, a date for a wedding must be arranged **at least** six months prior to the wedding. Call the church **FIRST**, before you schedule a reception venue! Contact the rectory with any questions.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

CENTENNIAL CORNER

This Sunday we welcome St. Mary's School alumni back to the pews where they once sat for daily Mass. Following the Sunday Noon alumni Mass, they'll head downstairs to the parish center to enjoy a re-enactment of a "once-a-month" hot lunch that was served when there was no hot lunch program. Everyone is invited to enjoy the sloppy joe/hot dog lunch from 11:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. The class of 2022 will serve ice cream, a fairly recent tradition added to this "once-a-month" tradition of long ago. Though the hot lunch cost alumni 55 cents long ago, a free will offering is appreciated. School tours were recently cancelled due to unfinished restroom renovations. We hope to be able to offer school tours at a later date. Thanks to the St. Mary's Home and School Association for their support of this centennial event as the new school year begins.

This weekend the only opportunity to purchase a centennial t-shirt, sweatshirt, license plate frame, a brick, or pre-order a centennial book will be during the sloppy joe/hot dog luncheon held in the parish center on Sunday. We will resume all sales next weekend, August 21/22. Thank you to everyone who purchased a centennial rosary. We sold out last Sunday!

This coming Saturday, St. Mary's will let the Bellevue community know that we have been a parish for 100 years as we participate in the annual Arrows to Aerospace parade which begins at 10:00 a.m. If you'd like to walk with us, please meet in front of the school at 9:30 a.m. If possible, wear your centennial t-shirt. This weekend's historical tidbits are school related:

- *In the files of St. Mary's rectory, the following typed notice for the local paper dated February 1946 was found: "Saint Mary's Catholic Church of Bellevue has plans to erect a parish school early this spring, according to pastor, Father Robert Garvey. It will be a one floor, four room school with all modern conveniences. Living quarters for three Sisters will be provided in an adjoining convent. The school and convent will be done in Spanish, or Mission, style to harmonize with the church. The two buildings will be erected on the piece of property running west of Calhoun on Mission St. which provides a wonderful view of the surrounding countryside. The lots were donated to Saint Mary's through the generosity of Mr. George Rushart."*
- *The school was dedicated on August 29, 1948 with the first day being September 6, 1948.*
- *An August 20, 1959 the Sarpy County Gazette article stated: "Attendance at Mass at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Bellevue has quadrupled in the past ten years from 500 to 2,000. During the same period the Catholic families of Bellevue have invested half a million dollars in a new church and school building. School enrollment more than quadrupled. It was 96 in 1949 and was 450 in 1959. The teacher staff grew from three to eleven. This fall there will be eight Sisters and four lay teachers in addition to the two priests who teach religion classes." The same edition stated that the convent was enlarged in 1956 most likely to accommodate the increased number of Sisters.*

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Narthex updates as of Wednesday August 4th: The dry-wall continues to be hung in the lower level. The exterior stain issues have been resolved and exterior staining should be completed by the end of this week. Once the exterior stain is completed, the trim will be installed. We hope that will be done by the end of next week. We are still working on the interior stain issues. The irrigation system work has been completed, except for drip lines that will be installed after the planting. We praise God that, after over seven months of production delays, our beautiful new wood doors have been delivered to our contractor. They will be installed after the interior of the Narthex is painted.

School bathroom renovations: As mentioned last week, we are renovating all 15 School and Dominican Center bathrooms. This is a major undertaking since the project needs to be completed (or near completion) by the start of school on August 16th. Some of them are the original bathrooms from the 1950's, and two are being made ADA compatible. The one item we need extra prayers for are the bathroom partitions. Their delivery dates continue to change. We will share pictures with you after the floors are finished, walls are painted and fixtures installed.
