A MESSAGE FROM MSGR. MIKE

Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We need each other. We were created to be in relationship with God and others. We are less than we are meant to be when we absent ourselves.

"A member of the church, who previously had been attending Mass regularly, stopped going. After a few months the pastor decided to visit him. It was a chilling evening. The pastor found the man at home alone, sitting before a blazing fire. Guessing the reason for his pastor's visit, the man welcomed him, led him to a comfortable chair near the fireplace and waited.

The pastor made himself at home but said nothing. In the grave silence, he contemplated the dance of the flames around the burning logs. After some minutes, the pastor took the fire tongs, carefully picked up a brightly burning ember and placed it to one side of the hearth all alone then he sat back in his chair, still silent. The host watched all this in quiet contemplation. As the one, lone ember's flame flickered and diminished, there was a momentary glow and then its fire was no more. Soon, it was cold and dead.

Not a word had been spoken since the initial greeting. The pastor glanced at his watch and realized it was time to leave. He slowly stood up, picked up the cold, dead ember and placed it back in the middle of the fire. Immediately it began to glow, once more with the light and warmth of the burning coals around it.

As the pastor reached the door to leave, his host said with a tear running down his cheek, 'Thank you so much for your visit and especially for the fiery sermon. I will be back at Mass on Sunday.'"



We live in a world today, which tries to say too much with too little. Consequently, few listen. Sometimes the best sermons are the ones left unspoken. We need each other and if even one parishioner is missing we are less than we ought to be. In this year of the Parish Eucharistic Revival let us be aware of those who are not here and make an effort to accompany them back home!






