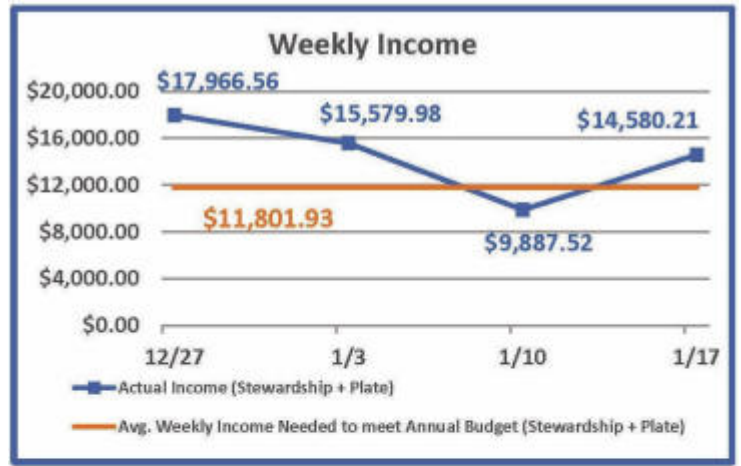

Information from Fr. Ernie's Desk

Keeping Us Safe

Someone asked me recently why we have some of the stalls and sinks closed off in the restrooms, something they have not seen at some other parishes. It's a good question. Reducing the number of stall and sinks in use makes cleaning easier and faster. We clean all high-contact surfaces after every Mass. Taking some "out of service" means that the process can go more quickly. If you find that you are having to wait for one to become available, please let me know. Cleaning after each Mass is just one of the many things we do to reduce the chance of spreading the virus. The most important ones are these:

- ◆ If you have a fever or any other possible symptom of the virus, or if you may have been exposed, please stay home.
- ◆ Wear a mask at all times while you are in the building.
- ◆ Please try to stay six feet away from others.
- ◆ If you must cough or sneeze, leave your mask on and add another layer – a handkerchief or your sleeve.
- ◆ Clean your hands often, especially before coming to communion, and after you touch your mask.

Distribution of Ashes

Different parts of the world distribute ashes in different ways. In all Catholic churches all over the world, ashes are "placed on the head," but the rubrics (rules) do not specify **where** on the head. I didn't realize that. I have only seen them placed on the forehead in the sign of a cross. In other parts of the world, including the Vatican, they are sprinkled on the top of the head. This year, to reduce the chance of spreading the virus from person to person, churches around the world will do it the Vatican way. In more ancient times, ashes were tossed on the penitents – outside in front of the church. Don't worry, I won't be throwing handfuls of ashes anywhere. Remember, too, that ashes are not mandatory. May they help all of us repent of our selfish sinfulness.

Priesthood? Maybe?

If you might enjoy meeting with some others who are thinking about it, there's a dinner on Thursday, February 4th that you are invited to attend. Let me know and I'll tell you more and go with you. I've also wondered about meeting with others who thought about priesthood before deciding against it. What can we learn from each other? Are you interested?

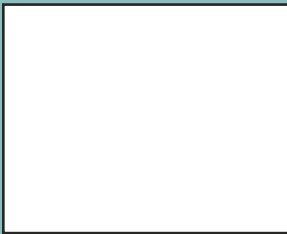
