

Christ the King and Religious Liberty

Today's Solemn feast of Christ the King was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as a response to the problem of what he referred to as "Anti-clericalism," by which he meant the attitude of those who were seeking to remove Christian influence from political life. Hmmm. Interesting that it still is happening today as we've recently heard suggestions that belief in Catholic teachings renders a person unfit for a supreme court position, but if a Catholic opposes Church teachings it is acceptable for that person to take on public office.



When our nation is surrounded by civic unrest, racial tension, and a pandemic, we do well to turn to our God, who is the King of every people and nation and the entire universe.

Pope Pius wrote in declaring this feast; "His kingship is founded upon the ineffable hypostatic union. From this it follows not only that Christ is to be adored by angels and men, but that to him as man angels and men are subject, and must recognize his empire; by reason of the hypostatic union Christ has power over all creatures." Quas Primas, 13

Our theology is that Jesus is fully human and fully man. He is both the divine Lord and the man who suffered and died on the Cross. In him, one person of the Trinity unites himself to human nature and reigns over all creation as the Incarnate Son of God.

By being close to others who are suffering, we draw close to Jesus. As Catholics, we can look for opportunities to minister to the needs of people who are hurting and, by doing so, we will be acknowledging the kingship of Christ. WE should do this together as a parish and as individuals.

We also pay honor and due respect to Christ as King in our true desire to receive Him in the Eucharist at Mass, by participating in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament or our First Friday Holy Hours, or just visits to the Church during the day to visit the tabernacle. Christ is truly present in the Eucharist in no other way possible.

Today, religious freedom for many people means that we can believe whatever we want, but when we enter the public square or the marketplace or workplace, we should conform to the secular world which opposes God. For Christians, when our faith is repeatedly marginalized in public life, we can fall into the habit of compartmentalizing our lives. We love Jesus in our private lives, but we hide from acknowledging the dominion of Christ in social life. When we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, we declare to the world and remind ourselves that Jesus is the Lord, not only of the Church, but of the universe and all within it.




Advent is a season of waiting and preparation for the celebration of the Nativity of Jesus; a time to prepare our hearts for the coming of our Savior. These four weeks are a time of expectant waiting, knowing fully the amazing gift that God is about to deliver.

This Advent season, beginning on November 28/29 we are promoting our Advent Circle of Kindness. The Advent wreath, a circle that has no beginning or end, symbolizes the eternity of God and the everlasting life offered by Christ. The four candles break through the darkness, reminding us of the Light of Christ. Our hope is that you and your family are inspired by the magical season of Advent, this circle of unending love in which we are called to be instruments of Christ and share joy to everyone we meet.

Each week during Advent we ask every member of our community to focus on the Advent circle of kindness. On the first Saturday of Advent we will host an advent lighting service, directly following the 4:00 pm liturgy. We will gather around the circle drive outside the front of the church and light our first Advent candle. For your act of kindness we would like you to write a card to a resident at a nursing home or someone who may be homebound. You can bring your cards to the liturgy you attend and we can get them to the residents at a nursing home or mail them to a parishioner who may not be able to get out during this pandemic. This is a great way to bring hope into someone's life, who may just need some spiritual uplifting.

Every week we will ask you and your family to participate in the hope of the season by participating in Corpus' Advent Circle of Kindness. Look forward to more Advent opportunities to share kindness.


Thanksgiving Blessing to Everyone

Christmas Poinsettias and Decorations




Holy Communion Outside of Mass

This Sunday, at 10:55 am we will be offering Holy Communion in the circle drive of the church. We encourage you to either watch any live-stream mass or tune into 100.9 FM prior to receiving communion at church. Any one interested in receiving communion in their car should be in the parking lot by 10:55 am. Be sure to turn your radio to station 100.9 FM and listen for instructions. **If it is raining or snowing there will be no communion outside.**

Listen in the Lot

Every Sunday at the 10:00 am liturgy we will offer an opportunity to hear mass on the radio. You will be able to park anywhere on campus to listen to Fr. Jerry celebrate the Eucharist by tuning into 100.9 FM. This is a great option for many during this pandemic. Holy Communion will be distributed after the liturgy in the church circle drive.



Giving Tuesday was created when two organizations, the 92nd Street Y and the United Nations Foundation came together in 2012, about a month before that year's Thanksgiving. Their intention was to set aside a day that was all about celebrating the virtue of charity — a great American tradition.

Giving Tuesday is organized and celebrated each year on the heels of Black Friday and Cyber Monday, with the simple aim of encouraging individuals, families, schools, businesses, and other organizations to be charitable. Giving Tuesday has been praised by many, including the Chronicle of Philanthropy, a newspaper that covers the nonprofit world, as an antidote to consumer culture and a way for people to give back. There is no shortage of ways in which this can be done and no shortage of worthy causes that so many of you give to from time to time. The hashtag #GivingTuesday was also created to raise awareness and encourage people to give to charities.

This year, Corpus Christi will be joining in this day of giving with #iGiveCatholic opportunities to help our parish offset the costs of COVID-19: PPE for teachers and staff, air filtration and



1st RECONCILIATION & 1st EUCHARIST: Preparation is a 2 year program that begins with 1st Graders who are enrolled in Religious Education or Catholic School. During the 2nd year of preparation, the 2nd grade students will complete First Reconciliation and First Eucharist. CONFIRMATION: Preparation is a 2 year process that begins for 7th Graders who have been enrolled in the RE or Catholic School. The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated in the Fall of their 9th Grade Year. Contact Kristi at re@cccparish.org.

MATRIMONY: The Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas requires couples to make arrangements at least six months in advance of the date of marriage. Please call the parish office for an appt. and arrange for marriage prep. classes. Marriages are not celebrated during Lent.
