

Gaudete - Rejoice for God is Near

Catholic Christians traditionally call this “Gaudete Sunday” (Latin “to rejoice”) from the Entrance Antiphon to stress the joy of anticipating the Lords coming. Not only that, but hopefully, our added prayer during this Advent and our Acts of kindness and confessing our sins and receiving sacramental absolution have brought joy to our hearts and homes as well.

Prophets are sent to help the people return to God’s ways. Throughout the Old Testament, God’s people strayed from his ways and were pulled back by a truth-telling prophet. John the Baptist was the last of the apostles, and he made ready the way of the Lord with a message of repentance.

It is sometimes difficult for parishes and others to resist singing or listening to “O Come, Emmanuel” until December 17th. This hymn is based on the “O Antiphons,” which serve as the antiphons for the Magnificat at Evening Prayer and the verses of the Gospel Acclamation at Masses from December 17-23; a different verse is sung each day. The images are so rich that in the Middle Ages, they were woven into a hymn that became associated with the entire season of Advent.

“O Wisdom,” “O Sacred Lord,” “O Flower of Jesse’s Stem,” “O Key of David,” “O Radiant Dawn,” “O King of All Nations,” and the most expected and greatest of them all, “O Emmanuel.” They end December 23rd, because evening prayer on December 24th is the beginning of the Christmas vigil. The original Latin titles for these images formed an acrostic to reveal a hidden message. The first letter of each phrase added to the next and then reversed spelled Ero Cras, or “I will come tomorrow.”

Whenever they are prayed or sung, these images intend to inspire awe and wonder. They leave us with the speechless response of “Oh!” as we contemplate the multiple images that Christ fulfills.

Please consider joining us for a special time of prayer and reflection Thursday, December 17th at 6:00 in the Church to reflect on these beautiful antiphons. There will be scripture and other spiritual readings, music and some silence too, followed by a reception with wine and cheese (all prepared in social individual containers and glasses and while practicing physical distancing as always).




Week 4: Cup of Kindness for First Responders



The Roman Church has been singing the "O" Antiphons since at least the eighth century. They are the antiphons that accompany the Magnificat canticle of Evening Prayer from December 17-23. The predominant theme is messianic, stressing the hope of the Savior's coming.

One of our opening songs during Advent, Come, Lord Jesus, Come and the hymn O Come, O come Emmanuel are songs that are based on the "O" Antiphons. Each verse of the hymn parallels with one of the antiphons and they add a mood of eager expectation to the liturgy that builds throughout these seven days and climaxes at Christmas.

The antiphons are, in fact, a collage of Old Testament types of Christ. Jesus is invoked by various titles, mainly taken from the prophet Isaiah. The sequence progresses historically, from the beginning, before creation, to the very gates of Bethlehem. Each O Antiphon begins with an invocation of the expected Messiah, followed by praise of him under one of his particular titles. Each ends with a petition for God's people, relevant to the title by which he is addressed, and the cry for him to "Come" which embodies the longing of all for the Divine Messiah. The 'O' Antiphons illustrate the fullness of time. All the antiphons reflect this eternity encompassing the past, present and future, the key moments of Salvation History. These beautiful antiphons are like a drum roll growing to a crescendo as the seven days bring us closer to the Christmas miracle of God made flesh, born as a babe and, with few exceptions, mostly unnoticed by mankind.

The seven titles attributed to Jesus in the antiphons are Wisdom (Sapientia in Latin), Ruler of the House of Israel (Adonai), Root of Jesse (Radix), Key of David (Clavis), Rising Dawn (Oriens), King of the Gentiles (Rex). and Emmanuel.

In Latin the initials of the titles make an acrostic which, when read backwards, means: "Tomorrow I will be there" ("Ero cras"). Therefore, the Lord Jesus, whose coming we have prepared for in Advent and whom we have addressed in these seven Messianic titles, now speaks to us, and brings intensity to our Advent preparation, but bring it to a joyful conclusion.



We invite you to an Advent Evening of Prayer and Reflection on Thursday, December 17th at 6:00 pm. Our evening will reflect on the O Antiphons. We hope that you will be able to join us that evening as we reflect on these beautiful antiphons with scripture, spiritual readings, prayer, silence and song. A reception will follow with wine and cheese (all prepared in social individual containers and glasses and while practicing physical distancing as always).

Year End Giving

How Covid Affects Charitable Giving

The authors of the CARES Act rightly recognized the desire of benefactors to support non-profit organizations in this era of financial hardship. From a tax-benefit standpoint, now is a great time to give, and tax laws are favorable no matter the level at which you are giving:

- There is now no limit to the deductions you can take for charitable contributions if you itemize your contributions. Previously you could only deduct up to a max of 60% of adjusted gross income (AGI). Under new guidelines, 100% of your contribution is tax deductible. And there is a carry-forward, for those who give more than their AGI.
- Anyone who gives up to \$300 can get an easy tax break. Previously, itemization was required for any tax break. Under the CARES Act, taxpayers can take a deduction up to \$300 even if they don't itemize on their 2020 tax form.
- Corporations can receive a higher tax break for their charitable giving.
- Anyone can donate food and get a tax deduction.


Holy Water Dispensers
