“The Role of a Deacon”

Why does the priest not read the Gospel at Mass? Why did Fr. Jerry change where the priest sits during Mass? Why does the Deacon wear a different garment than the priest in Church?

As you know, Corpus Christi has been assigned Deacon Chris Allen to ministry as our parish. Deacon Chris was ordained this past May and this is the first Deacon that our parish has had for some time, so I thought it about time I help to answer some questions.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church speaks of the Sacrament of Holy Orders in this way: Catholic doctrine, expressed in the liturgy, the Magisterium, and the constant practice of the Church, recognizes that there are two degrees of ministerial participation in the priesthood of Christ: the episcopacy (bishops) and the presbyterate (priests). The diaconate is intended to help and serve them. For this reason the term sacerdos in current usage denotes bishops and priests but not deacons. Yet Catholic doctrine teaches that the degrees of priestly participation (episcopate and presbyterate) and the degree of service (diaconate) and all three conferred by a sacramental act called "ordination," that is, by the Sacrament of Holy Orders. The deacon participates as an evangelizer and teacher in the Church's mission of heralding the word. In the liturgy of the word, especially in the Eucharist or in those liturgies where he is the presiding minister, the deacon proclaims the Gospel. He may preach by virtue of ordination and in accord with the requirements of Canon Law.



During the Mass the deacon participates in specific penitential rites as prescribed in the Roman Missal. He proclaims the Gospel and may preach a homily. He voices the needs of the people in the Universal Prayers (petitions), and assists the priest and other ministers in accepting the gifts and he prepares the altar. He may extend the invitation of peace, and serves as an ordinary minister of Communion. Deacons have a special responsibility for the distribution of the cup. He dismisses the community at the end of Mass, and his proper place in the sanctuary is to the right of the presider.

Other liturgical roles for which the deacon is authorized include those of solemnly baptizing, witnessing marriages outside of Mass, bringing viaticum to the dying, and presiding over funerals and burials. The deacon can preside at the liturgies of the word and communion services in the absence of a priest. He may officiate at celebrations of the Liturgy of the Hours and at exposition and benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. He can conduct public rites of blessing, offer prayer services for the sick and dying, and administer the Churches' sacramentals.

Traditionally, the role of the Deacon is one of service to the poor and in social justice issues. They would assist the priest and bishop in bringing Christ to those in need. In addition to his assignment here at Corpus Christi, Deacon Chris is also assigned to help with pro-life efforts in our Archdiocese.

We are blessed to have Deacon Chris in ministry here at Corpus and in our Archdiocese. And by the way, the years of study and formation that Deacon Chris received would be one of the many ministries funded through the Archbishops' Call To Share.

Each year after we ring in the New Year, Archbishop Naumann begins his Annual Appeal: A Call to Share (ACTS). The planning for this annual appeal is a year-long process of people coming together and looking at the needs of the people that we are called to serve as the Church of Northeast Kansas. The year-long planning process is not about how to increase the amount of dollars secured by the appeal, but rather a constant look at the needs that are present among the people that are served by our parishes and by the offices of the Archdiocese that work tirelessly in ministry with children and the elderly; with people of color and those with disabilities; with young couples preparing for a life together and all those who find themselves marginalized in our society. This was Christ's call to all disciples.

Our call to Stewardship each year in the parish's annual drive is a reminder to all of us that we are responsible for the gifts that God has bestowed on each of us — and as stewards of God's gifts we are called to return a portion of them. Our annual Stewardship drive asks all parishioners to work toward a five percent return of your financial gifts to the parish itself, to offer another one percent toward the annual appeal by the Archbishop through ACTS, and to use the remaining four percent toward the charities that are also close to your heart. We also ask for your time and talents to make all of our various parish ministries possible (and post COVID-19 we will be looking to add ministries). This is what Stewardship as a disciple of Jesus calls us to: a life of trust and relationship with the God who has bestowed gifts upon us. It is not a simple request, but one that demands a look inside of ourselves to find the trust and the faith to respond when we are called upon.

Financial Stewardship Goal: 10% of our gifts returned to God

- 5% to your parish
- 1% to the Archbishop's Annual Appeal (ACTS)
- 4% that can be used for parish capital needs or other charities (i.e. United Way, St. Jude's, American Cancer Society, Corpus League of Angels, Parish Education Endowment, William's Fund)

It is easy, and often a favorite pastime, to look at anything that comes with the Archdiocesan name tacked onto it as something outside of who we are. An "us" versus "them" mentality sometimes guides our thoughts when we are asked for dollars or time and talent at the Archdiocesan level. We think, *I would rather keep my dollars here, or, I don't know what they do with that money.* In reality, as a Catholic parish, "We are "them!" There is no Corpus Christi Catholic Community without the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas. And the dollars that we offer to this annual appeal benefit all of us in two ways. First, Msgr. Krische and I are priests of the Archdiocese and were educated in part by the funds that come from this annual appeal. Right now we are educating seminarians that will in the future serve this parish, or other parishes that you may find yourself part of in this Archdiocese. Second, many of the programs and ministries funded by this annual appeal directly affect hundreds of our families. The School Office sets the curriculum and supports our parish school, the Office of Evangelization does the same for our Children's Religious Education program. Marriage and Family Life helps in setting our young couples on the path of marriage, the Youth Office oversees the work done at Prairie Star Ranch, our youth camp. In the same light, all those other offices and ministries do the work that we are all called to do, and they do it in our name.

Monsignor and I are asking that you prayerfully consider a gift to this annual appeal. It is an important part of our ministry and our call to follow Christ. As you read Archbishop Naumann's message on Call to Share on page 2, know that we will all receive a letter asking for financial support for his annual appeal. Please respond quickly by mailing your gift or bringing it directly to church and placing in the collection basket. All gifts are greatly appreciated, and everyone can offer something. Thanks for your gift and for being such an important part of our parish family! - Fr. Jerry & Msgr. Vince

Eucharistic Adoration is the worship of the Eucharist outside of the Mass. The Eucharistic Host is displayed in a monstrance on the altar so that all can see and pray in the presence of Christ. The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that, "Adoration is the first attitude of man acknowledging that he is a creature before his Creator. It exalts the greatness of the Lord who made us and the almighty power of the Savior who sets us free from evil. Adoration is homage of the spirit to the "King of Glory," respectful silence in the presence of the "ever greater" God. Adoration of the thrice-holy and sovereign God of love blends with humility and gives assurance to our supplications." (CCC 2628) We can show our adoration to God in many ways, but in Eucharistic Adoration, we spend time adoring the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

During Lent, we invite you to spend Tuesdays with Jesus from 9:00 am-9:00 pm. This is a great opportunity to have a deep personal encounter with Jesus. Lent is a period of fasting, praying, giving and self-discipline in preparation of the season of Easter. This spiritual growth and conversion is a way to transform our whole being, body, soul and spirit to help us become more like Christ.

During the 12 hours of Tuesdays with Jesus we need to have at least 2 different households sign up every hour to pray before the exposed blessed sacrament. Once exposed, the Blessed Sacrament must never be left alone. Anyone would be welcome to come and pray in the Church during those 12 hours, but we must have people committed to guard and to pray at all times. The distribution of ashes will happen at all of these liturgies. During this season we are called upon to look more closely at the paschal mystery of God's saving action: the life, the suffering, the death and the resurrection that brings about our salvation. 

Pastoral Council Members Needed

The Pastoral Council shall serve as a consultative group to the pastor, to assist him in fostering pastoral activities and in providing for the continued growth of parish life. The areas of focus include:

- The spiritual formation and growth of the people of the parish;
- The education of adults and youth in the faith;
- The fostering and nurturing of “community” in the parish;
- The evangelization of the non-participative Catholics in the parish and the unchurched;
- Witnessing to the Gospel of social justice in one’s community through service.

The members of the Pastoral Council will provide information and make recommendations, which reflect the spirit of the parish, in order to advise the pastor concerning decisions affecting the life of the parish community;

- Be responsible with the pastor for the pastoral planning of the parish, including ecumenical activities;
- Review, evaluate, and make recommendation to the pastor and the Parish Finance Council concerning the funding of parish programs;
- Provide the communications, coordination, and cooperation among the parish members, its organizations, and committees.
- Participate in and cooperate with regional and diocesan decisions pertaining to parish life.

The Council ideally will be composed of 9 members representing a wide variety of parish membership including young adults and seniors, newly married or single, parents of children in private and public schools, etc. Variety is a blessing because it is what makes up every parish and the universal Church. Sacramental Guidelines

BAPTISM: Baptism preparation classes for the parent/s are offered the first Saturday of the month at 9:00 am with Fr. Jerry. Parents are encouraged to take the class early in the pregnancy. Register at cccparish.org/baptism.

1st RECONCILIATION & 1st EUCHARIST: Preparation is a 2 year program that begins with 1st Graders who are enrolled in Religious Education or Catholic School.
