

# Fr. Jerry's FORUM



## Gathering as Church in Church

Nobody ever said it had to be perfect! Lucky for us, God understands our human nature and the stuff of daily life that gets in the way, so how we come to Mass is not as important as just getting there.

The reality for many people now coming out of this pandemic is to get back into the habit. It means the reality of getting ready in time; looking for the lost shoe, changing the baby's diaper, ironing the only clean shirt, arguing with the kids about actually waking up to go to church, struggling behind a driver who insists on driving 15 miles below the speed limit, and then waiting to be ushered into a pew in a place I would rather not sit in Church because of the precautions that Corpus is still trying to take to keep us all healthy and safe. All of these experiences are part of the Gathering Rite for Sunday Mass.


Yes, most of these 'problems' could be avoided with careful planning and some greater effort -- maybe preparing for Mass should begin a day or two before.

Take that thought a little bit further. The time at Mass is spent with and for people we call our brothers and sisters. Perhaps then we should begin to prepare for this time a little earlier in the week because we care about the others in our family and aren't just in it for ourselves. At Liturgy we pray for the church and for the world. Maybe that is why it is good to keep in touch with what is going on in the parish and our community and world so that we know what to pray for or about. Since we listen to the scriptures every Sunday, maybe it would be good to read them prior to coming so they are more familiar to us. Get the idea? We should always be working on what should be happening. But if we keep looking and waiting for what should be, we will miss what is real.



We come to the liturgy prepared as best we can knowing that our preparation will not be perfect. This is just reality. We greet one another as we arrive and we begin to leave a little bit of the recent happenings of our lives behind. We sing together -- we hear the voices of those around us both perfect and imperfect. We make the sign of the cross as a visible sign that we are the body of Christ. And we pray --- we make the transition from the world that should be, to the world of what is real: Christ present in the Church gathered together.

*Disrupt our comfortable lives and complacent attitudes with new ideas to respond courageously and creatively with a daily 'YES!' Amen.*

## Pope Francis' Highlights on World Day of Prayer for Vocations

As the protector of Jesus and the church, St. Joseph can be a model for all vocations, which are meant to be the “ever-active hands of the Father, outstretched to his children,” the pope wrote in the message. St. Joseph has “the heart of a father, able to give and generate life in the midst of daily routines,” which is the same aim of vocations, he wrote. “The Lord desires to shape the hearts of fathers and mothers: hearts that are open, capable of great initiatives, generous in self-giving, compassionate in comforting anxieties and steadfast in strengthening hopes”. Pope Francis asked that St. Joseph protect vocations and that men and women see how God’s call will make their greatest dreams come true; respond with generous service and attentive care; and live with simple, joyful fidelity.

### Heart of a Father

St. Joseph, said the Pope, is an extraordinary figure, not because of any astonishing charism or special status, but because he accomplished extraordinary acts of service in his daily life. “God looks on the heart,” he said, “and in Saint Joseph He recognized the heart of a father, able to give and generate life in the midst of daily routines”. Vocations, he added, have the same goal of begetting and renewing the lives of others. The priesthood and consecrated life, he said, require men and women with open hearts, who are “capable of great initiatives, generous in self-giving, compassionate in comforting anxieties and steadfast in strengthening hopes”.

### Chasing a Dream

Pope Francis went on to focus on three key words which St. Joseph suggests for each individual’s vocation: dream, service, and fidelity. The Gospel of Matthew recounts four dreams with which God inspired St. Joseph, each of which represented a difficult call from God. “After each dream, Joseph had to change his plans and take a risk, sacrificing his own plans in order to follow the mysterious designs of God, whom he trusted completely”. Though it seems strange to us that he would put so much trust in dreams, the Saint let himself be guided without hesitation. “Why”? mused the Pope. “Because his heart was directed to God; it was already inclined towards Him. A small indication was enough for his watchful 'inner ear' to recognize God’s voice”. God’s call to each of us, said Pope Francis, happens in the same way, without putting pressure on our freedom. “He does not overwhelm us with dazzling visions but quietly speaks in the depths of our heart, drawing near to us and speaking to us through our thoughts and feelings”. Yet, as St. Joseph demonstrates, our acceptance of God’s call cannot be passive, but requires us to press forward and take risks by abandoning ourselves to grace.

### Serving and Protecting

Pope Francis then considered St. Joseph’s vocation to service. “The Gospels show how Joseph lived entirely for others and never for himself,” he said. “By freeing love from all possessiveness, he became open to an even more fruitful service”. His limitless, selfless love led the Saint to sustain daily sacrifices, as a rule for daily life. “He adapted to different circumstances with the attitude of those who do not grow discouraged when life does not turn out as they wished,” said the Pope. “He showed the willingness typical of those who live to serve”. Pope Francis added that he likes to think of St. Joseph as the “protector of vocations,” since his willingness to serve fills him with a “concern to protect”. “Such thoughtful concern is the sign of a true vocation,” he said, “the testimony of a life touched by the love of God”.

### In Simple, Daily Fidelity

Fidelity, said the Pope, is the third aspect of St. Joseph’s example for all consecrated persons. He always patiently pondered his actions, and knew that “success in life is built on constant fidelity to important decisions”. Pope Francis said God teaches each of us how to nurture fidelity “in the light of God’s own faithfulness”. “This fidelity is the secret of joy,” he noted. “It the joy of simplicity, the joy experienced daily by those who care for what truly matters: faithful closeness to God and to our neighbor”.

### Example of Joy

The Pope concluded his message for World Day of Prayer for Vocations by urging the Church’s ministers to fill their homes with this same “simple and radiant, sober and hopeful joy”. “I pray that you will experience this same joy, dear brothers and sisters who have generously made God the dream of your lives, serving him in your brothers and sisters through a fidelity that is a powerful testimony in an age of ephemeral choices and emotions that bring no lasting joy”.


## *Donum Fidei Auction*

**Gospel Meditation**

Any builder worth his or her salt knows the value and importance of a cornerstone. Properly laying and securing



this primary unit determines how the rest of the project unfolds and its success. Cornerstones are necessary elements not only of buildings but of lives as well. Many human beings conduct the

business of their lives paying little attention to a grounding reference or starting point. Hence, what unfolds is a tapestry of relativism, with few anchors or guideposts and many impulsive choices. Some consider love to be their cornerstone. While this may sound attractive and useful, the pursuit of love without a simultaneous pursuit of its source can be shallow and self-focused. Just because a person chooses to do no harm and love others does not mean that they are living in truth and properly anchored to the real cornerstone.

Jesus is the true and authentic cornerstone and shepherd. It is only in following the Risen One as the way, the truth, and the life that we can move from being well grounded ethical people to properly focused moral ones. Proper conduct, a true sense of justice, wisdom, virtue, moral principles, faith, hope, and love will be difficult to find unless we listen to the right Voice. It is when we learn to listen to the voice of God that we begin our journey on the road to salvation. It is only the Good Shepherd, the authentic and solid cornerstone, who can guide us through life's questions and challenges and bring us to the safe and proper pasture.

A person's life only has meaning when the cornerstone is properly selected and set. Understanding themselves only as random acts of creation, existing without intent or purpose, will color their choices and influence their decisions. The foundation of their lives will be simply a matter of preference and choice, leaving benchmarks of growth and higher ideals optional to pursue. Whereas people who believe that they are fashioned and loved into existence by a God who purposely made them, have this incredible unconditional relationship at their source which has tremendous significance. Their allegiance is not to themselves but to their Creator. Life, then, is an adventure in search of this Creator God and a journey of self-discovery that seeks to unite their will to His. There is a cost. We have to give up our life in order to gain our life. As ironic as that sounds, it is true. It is only when we finally figure this out that the true cornerstone of our lives will be properly laid and we can, with God's help, get about the business of properly constructing a temple that endures.

## A New Playground for Corpus!!

We have exciting news! At the end of the 2020-21 school year, our playground refresh will begin! In addition to the large equipment going into the unoccupied dirt area (see picture), we will also be retiring the free-standing twisted slide piece of equipment. We will be installing a "Retro Rocker", somewhat similar to a teeter-totter, in its place. In the Northeast corner, we will be adding square footage to the playground by removing the landscaping in that corner and installing a three piece playground "band". It includes tuned drums, a cymbal tree and a xylophone. All of these are pleasantly tuned to work together. Our funnel ball equipment inside the fence area will be retired and two new funnel ball equipment pieces will be installed over in the blacktop area. We are also going to be adding some low animals (thank you Tom and Marilyn Dobski and McDonalds) to the "grass" area for our youngest Saints along with a new ladybug drum.

We are also planning to install additional soft surface under our new equipment and resurface the whole area. We are humbled to announce that we received a grant for \$10,511.25 from the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) Waste Tire Grant Program. This grant will help us off-set the cost to repair and resurface our playground. We are so excited for our Saints, the children in our parish and the wider community to be able to enjoy an expanded offering in our playground. "Play is our brain's favorite way of learning".




## 50th Wedding Anniversary Celebration
