## From the Desk of Fr. McNea

This coming Saturday, January 22<sup>nd</sup>, is our joint parish listening session as we participate in the church-wide synod on synodality. I strongly encourage you to come and participate in this gathering. We begin at the Cathedral on January 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 9:30am, with a Holy Hour in church. This time of prayer will dispose our hearts and our minds for our gathering and will open us up to the presence and the prompting of the Holy Spirit. After the Holy Hour, we will gather in Holy Family Hall. This synod and our local participation in it is all about Christ and His Church. It is not about anyone of us and our personal agendas. It is about the Holy Spirit leading us, guiding us into greater communion, participation and faithful living of the mission of Jesus Christ as He calls us to do so through His Church. I am very grateful to Janet and Scott Macon for facilitating this session for our two parishes. Please keep our parish gathering and this entire synod process in your prayers. Thank you.

January 22<sup>nd</sup> is also the 49<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the US Supreme Court decision, Roe v. Wade, which allows a pregnant woman to choose to have an abortion without excessive government restriction. Another Supreme Court decision, issued that same day, Doe v. Bolton, allows for an abortion to be procured through the ninth month of pregnancy. As American Catholics, January 22<sup>nd</sup> is a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. This is a day of prayer and penance—prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion. May our prayer and our penance lead to the moral conversion that is necessary for respecting and revering the sanctity and dignity of human life. May our active and appropriate use of our political process lead to this respect and reverence being upheld in the laws of our states and of our nation. Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Unborn, pray for us!

## WEEKLY REFLECTION

How often do we fail to act, because we claim that we are not ready? We might say that we need more training, more experience, or that someone else is better suited to the needs that lie before us. I often underestimate my ability to do great things and miss opportunities that God puts before me. Most great men and women accomplish great things because they overcame their reluctance or insecurity to do what needed to be done when no one else would do it. We are called to live our faith, not on our time, but on God's.

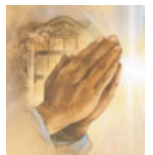
## ELIZABETH MINISTRY

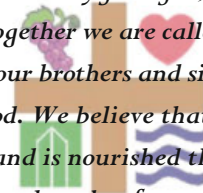
