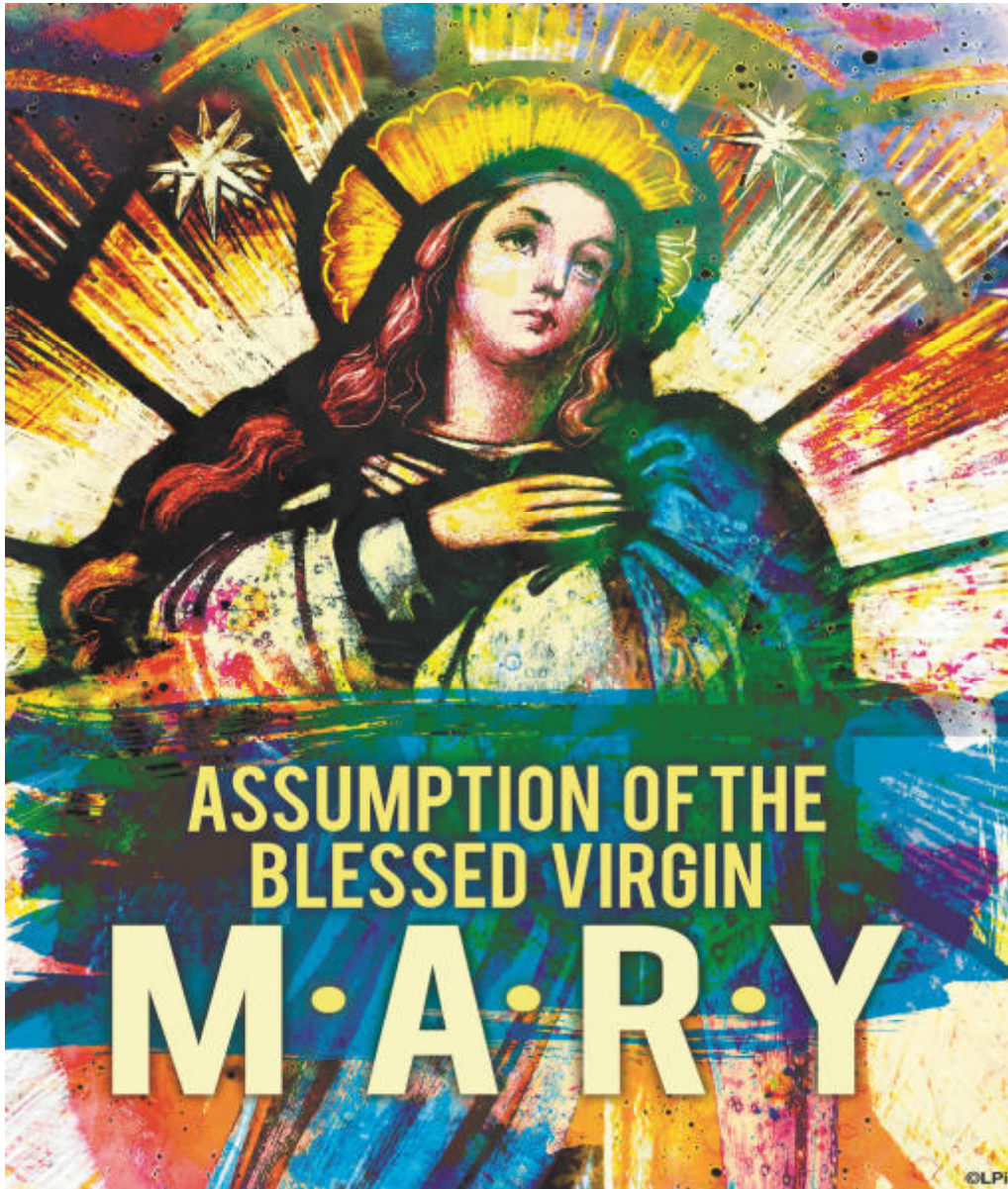

Dear Faithful of Sacred Heart,

What a beautiful solemnity we celebrate this weekend, the Assumption of Our Blessed Mother! Let's take a quick review of what exactly we celebrate this day, one author summarizes: "On November 1, 1950, in his apostolic constitution *Munificentissimus Deus*, Pope Pius XII infallibly proclaimed the truth of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary: 'the Immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever Virgin, when the course of her earthly life was ended, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven.' This dogma is deeply rooted in Scripture and has profound implications for all Christians."

The Assumption of Our Blessed Mother is a beautiful feast and a sparkling beam of hope for all mankind. Our Lord once told His Apostles: "And when I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also" (John 14:3). Our Lord fulfills this beautiful promise and gives us proof of its fulfillment pre-eminently in this feast. "In the Mother of God all can see actualized in a real human person what awaits all of God's children who are 'faithful unto death' and thus promised to receive the 'crown of life';

There is something that we have to realize when a Pope promulgates a dogma...he is not pulling this out of thin air; the Holy Spirit and divine providence have led him to give full definition to a particular truth at a particular time, and to do this infallibly as the successor of Peter. Pius XII said this about the Assumption: "This truth is based on Sacred Scripture and deeply embedded in the minds of the faithful; it has received the approval of liturgical worship from the earliest times; it is perfectly in keeping with the rest of revealed truth, and has been lucidly developed and explained by the studies, the knowledge and wisdom of theologians."

The next logical question to be asked is where in Scripture does it state that Mary is bodily present in Heaven? Well, if we look at the way Our Lord's body is referred to several times in Scripture we see that even He Himself refers to His body as the Temple of God. Well, in the same vein, if we look closely into Scripture we see that Our Blessed Mother's body is referred to as the new and true Ark of the Covenant. "Just as the new temple is Christ's physical body, the new ark is the glorified physical body of Mary. It was Jesus' physical body that suffered and was raised, and it was Mary's physical body that bore the Lord of heaven and earth. If that body is revealed to be in heaven, it had to have been assumed by God in order to get there."

St. John the Apostle, writing in the Book of Revelation testifies that he had a vision of the new ark of the covenant, but it wasn't what we expect: "when God's temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant was seen within his temple; and there were flashes of lightning, voices, peals of thunder, an earthquake, and heavy hail. And a great portent appeared in heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars" (Revelation 11:19-12:2)

We see in this text that St. John sees the New Ark in Heaven and it is our Blessed Mother. Furthermore, she is there bodily, clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and on her head a crown of twelve stars. My friends, what a joy to know we have a mother in Heaven, she desires all of us as her children to inherit the promise of the Kingdom of Heaven, stay close to her at all times in the Rosary and Hail Mary. Be assured of my prayers for all of you.

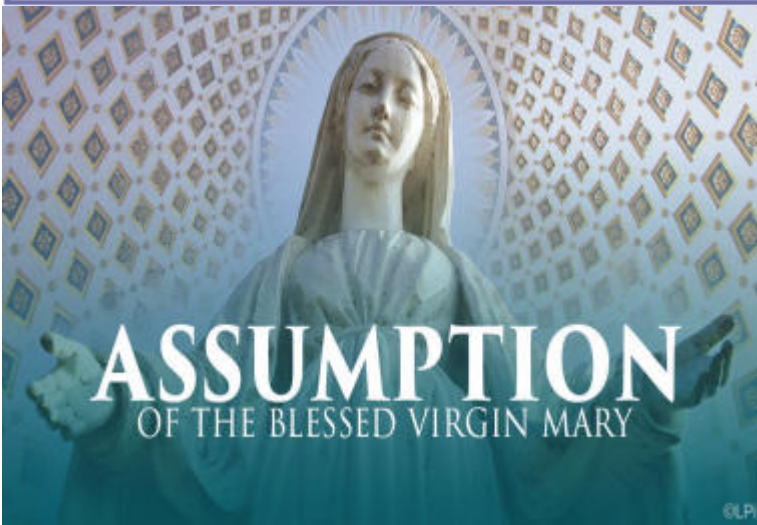

**Question:**  
 What lessons should I learn from the Assumption of Mary?

**Answer:**  
 Growing in holiness is similar to training in a sport. We need someone to show us how we can live our faith well. Mary is a model of sanctity. She shows us how to be faithful to God's will, living each day with confidence in God's mercy and love. At the Nativity, in Jesus' public ministry, and at the Crucifixion, we see her steadfast trust. She allows the Lord to use her life to accomplish his plan for her and for all of us. In the Preface of the Mass for the Assumption of Mary, we pray: "For today the Virgin Mother of God was assumed into heaven as the beginning and image of your Church's coming to perfection and a sign of sure hope and comfort to your pilgrim people."  
  
 It is this image of holiness that we strive to imitate. In the office, at home, or in our community, we look for signs of God's grace that call us to an ever greater love of him and each other. A greater awareness of God is a sign of our conversion of heart that lives the lessons Mary teaches.

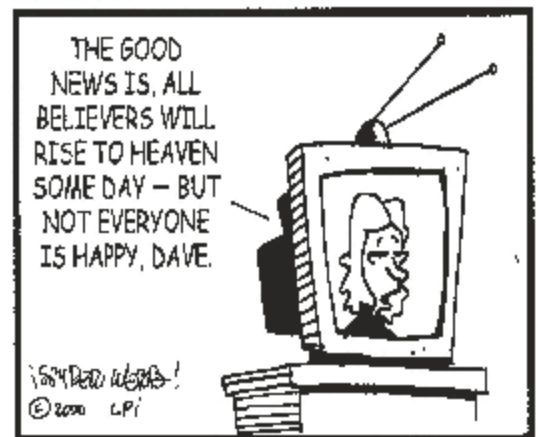
