From: With a Father's Heart, the Apostolic Letter of Pope Francis on St. Joseph



IN THE TEMPLE

Forty days after Jesus' birth, Joseph & Mary offered their child to the Lord & listened with amazement to Simeon's prophecy concerning Jesus & his Mother. To protect Jesus from Herod, Joseph dwelt as a foreigner in Egypt. After returning to his own country he led a hidden life in the tiny & obscure village of Nazareth in Galilee, far from Bethlehem, his ancestral town, & from Jerusalem and the Temple. Of Nazareth it was said, "No prophet is to rise" and indeed, "Can anything

good come out of Nazareth?" When, during a pilgrimage to Jerusalem, Joseph & Mary lost track of the 12-year-old Jesus, they anxiously sought him out & they found him in the Temple, in discussion with the doctors of the Law.
