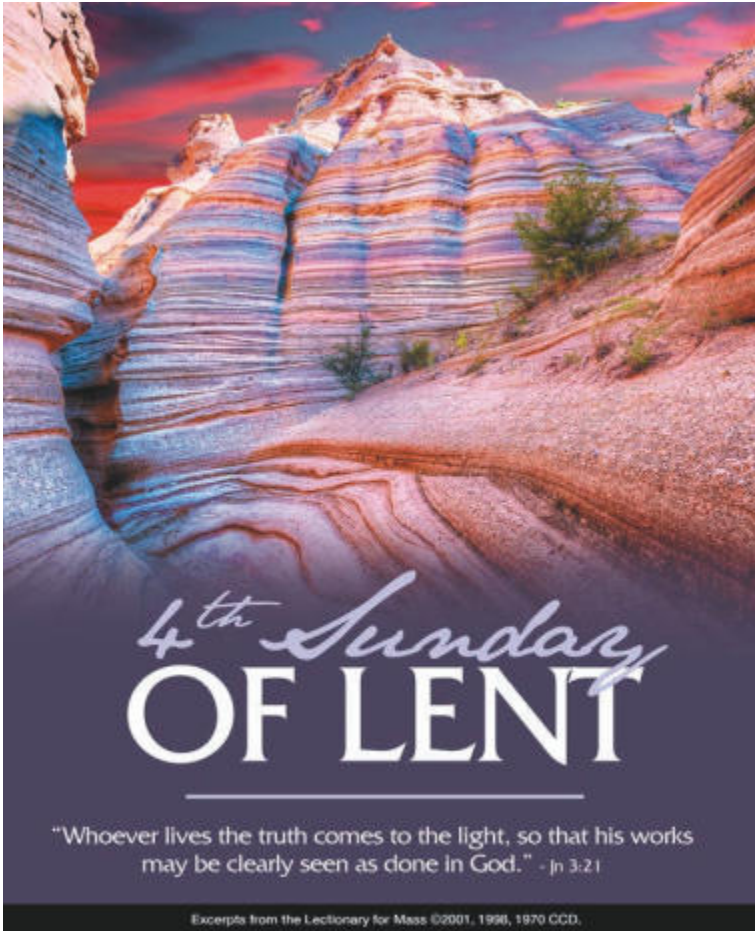

## 2021 - THE YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH

From: With a Father's Heart, the Apostolic Letter of Pope Francis on St. Joseph



Now, one hundred and fifty years after his proclamation as Patron of the Catholic Church by Blessed Pius IX, I would like to share some personal reflections on this extraordinary figure (Saint Joseph) so close to our own human experience. For as Jesus says, "out of abundance of the heart the mouth speaks". My desire to do so increased during these months of pandemic, when we experienced, amid the crisis, how "our lives are woven together and sustained by ordinary people, people often overlooked. People

who do not appear in newspaper and magazine headlines, or on the latest television show, yet in these very days are surely shaping the decisive events of our history. Doctors, nurses, storekeepers and supermarket workers, cleaning personnel, caregivers, transport workers, men and women working to provide essential services and public safety, volunteers, priests, men and women religious and so very many others. They understood that no one is saved alone.
