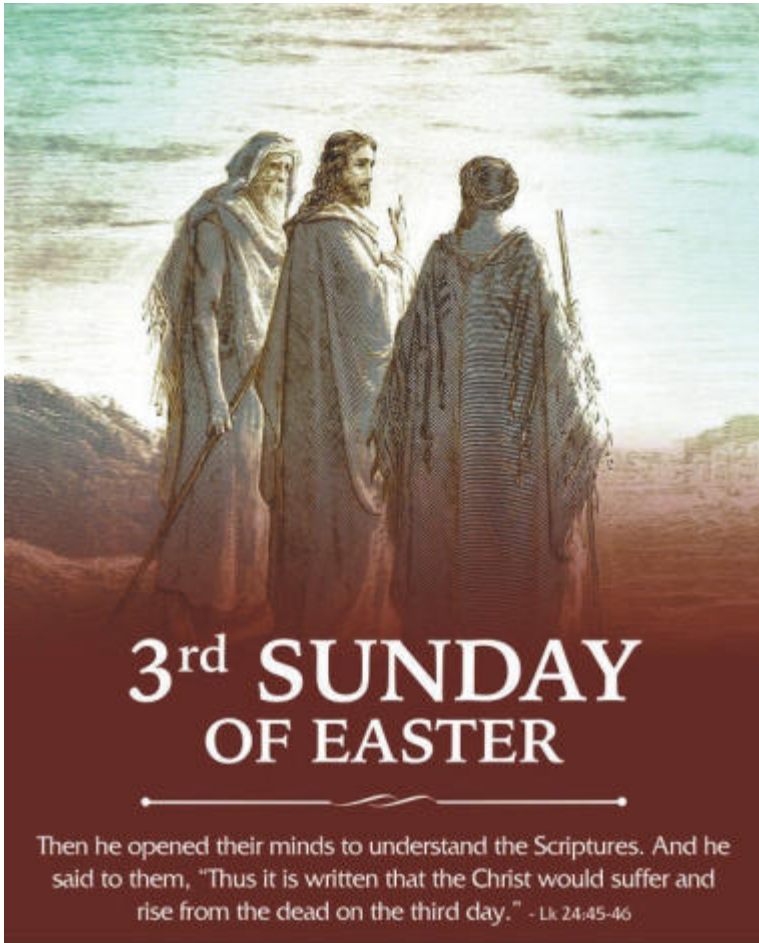

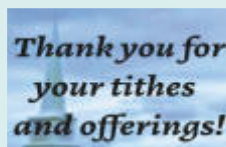

From: *With a Father's Heart*, the Apostolic Letter of Pope Francis on St. Joseph



Joseph saw Jesus grow daily "in wisdom and in years and in divine and human favor". As the Lord had done with Israel, so Joseph did with Jesus; he taught him to walk. Taking him by the hand; he was for him like a father who raises an infant to his cheeks, bending down to him and feeding him.

In Joseph, Jesus saw the tender love of God: "As a father has compassion for his children, so the Lord has

compassion for those who fear him". In the synagogue, during the praying of the Psalms, Joseph would surely have heard again and again that the God of Israel is a God of tender love, who is good to all, whose "compassion is over all that he has made."

CATHOLIC HISTORY IN KC

The Office of Diocesan Archives proudly announces the impending release of *Catholic Kansas City* written by diocesan archivist, Dr. Zach Daughtrey, with Bishop James V. Johnston, Jr. penning the book's forward. Published through Arcadia Publishing as part of their popular *Images of America* series, *Catholic Kansas City* is a pictorial history tracing the earliest foundations of Catholicism in Kansas City during the 1830s up through the second renovation of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in 2003.

Chapters exploring parishes, diocesan bishops, Catholic education, and more are included in the manuscript. *Catholic Kansas City* releases on Monday, April 5, 2021 and will be sold for \$21.99.
