After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Joe Crayon, at 816.812.2500 or <u>crayon@ombudsmankcsj.org</u> if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City–St. Joseph.
