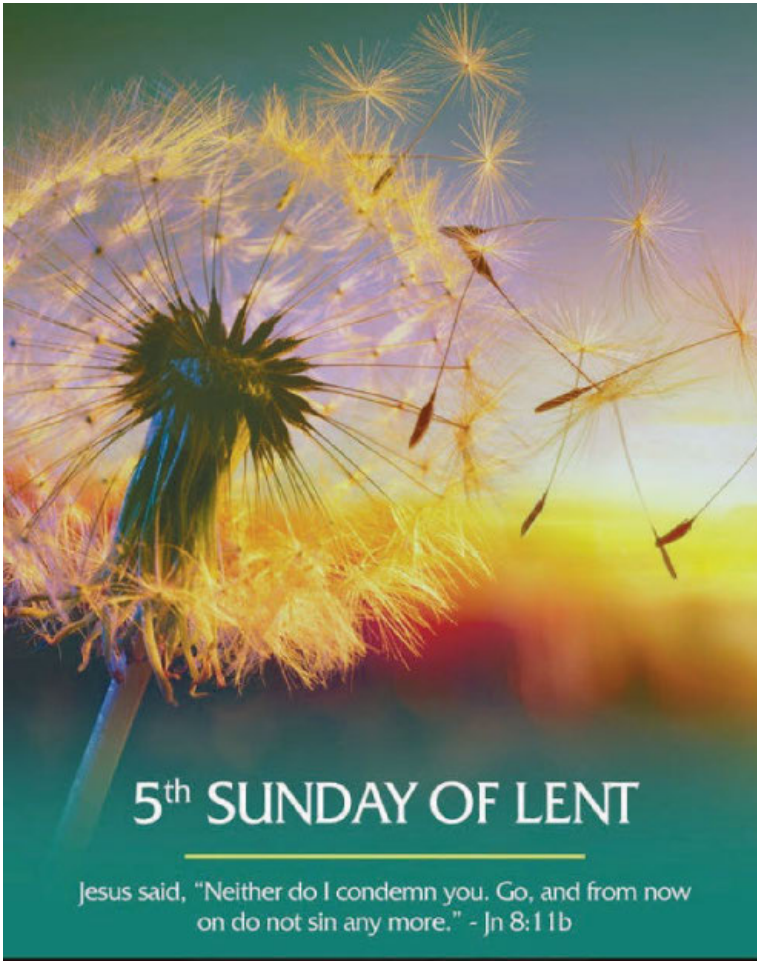

EASTER MEMORIALS

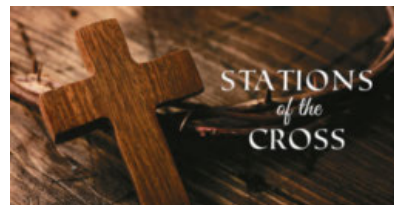
