May 2022 Financial Report

An average of \$18,000 in the collection is needed weekly to meet projected expenses.

What does this number mean?

St. Brendan Parish receives revenue from several sources. To pay for projected expenses, the weekly collection must average \$18,000. Revenue from other sources, such as from bequests and special one-time donations, grants, and tuition from school families who are not parishioners, is also needed in addition to the weekly collection to meet regular operational expenses.

If the weekly collection average is too low, how are the bills paid?

So far, St. Brendan has been able to pay bills despite a too-low weekly collection by drawing from savings and by receiving unexpected revenue (such as government money for COVID-19). However, grants and some special donations often cannot be used for regular operational expenses.



JUNE 19 - CORPUS CHRISTI

June 19 is the (transferred) solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. Following from the 9:00am Mass, we will have a solemn Eucharistic procession through Hardin Park followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament upon returning to the church.

"In the liturgy of the Mass we express our faith in the real presence of Christ under the species of bread and wine by, among other ways, genuflecting or bowing deeply as a sign of adoration of the Lord. The Catholic Church has always offered and still offers to the sacrament of the Eucharist the worship of adoration, not only during Mass, but also outside of it, reserving the consecrated hosts with the utmost care, exposing them to the solemn veneration of the faithful, and carrying them in procession." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1378)

Additionally, by consensus of the parish pastoral council, St. Brendan will offer to the faithful Holy Communion under the form of wine beginning on Corpus Christi. Christ is fully present under each form (bread or wine) and each part of them, meaning that it is not necessary for the faithful to receive under both forms. Therefore, those receiving Holy Communion may choose to receive under both forms or just the form of bread at your option. As always, if you are sick, please stay home from Mass out of concern for others.

MASS INTENTIONS

What Are Mass Intentions?

You may notice in our bulletin that most Masses are offered for a particular intention. Because the Mass is the mystical re-presentation of Christ's sacrifice on the cross, each Mass has in itself infinite spiritual value. This means that each Mass benefits the whole Church, both on earth and in purgatory, as well as advancing the good and salvation of the whole world.

At the same time, each Mass also benefits those who are in attendance, the priest who offers the Mass, and those who are prayed for during Mass, though all of this depends on the capacity of each person to receive these benefits. This is why we must go to Mass over and over again—we cannot absorb all the Mass's value all at once. Similarly, a sponge cannot absorb the whole ocean but can be dipped into it again and again to receive more and more.

The priest who offers the Mass can apply special fruits of that particular Mass to any intention he chooses. This is where Mass intentions come in. It is customary for the faithful to request that the Mass be offered for some particular intention. Pastors are also required to offer a Mass for the people of the parish at least every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation. This is to ensure that they are offering Mass for all the people entrusted to their care on a regular basis and not only taking special requests.

The Code of Canon Law states: "A priest is free to apply the Mass for anyone, living or dead." (canon 901)

A Mass intention is a form of prayer for that intention. You may notice at times that certain public figures are listed as Mass intentions. All of these intentions are requested by parishioners. This is not an endorsement or non-endorsement of any particular person's views. Christ commands us to pray for friends and enemies both.

If you have a particular intention for which you would like Mass to be offered, please contact the parish office (573)581-4720.

Is Money Given for Mass Intentions?

In many places throughout the world there is a custom of giving a donation when requesting that Mass be offered for a specific intention. This donation is entirely optional and can be any amount (\$10 is common) or nothing at all. In the Diocese of Jefferson City, donations received go to the regular parish income, not to the priest.


A donation given for a Mass intention is not the price of a Mass. The Mass is not being sold. If a donation is given, the Church has strict laws governing how the money is handled and how the donor's intention is fulfilled. This is why Mass intentions cannot be combined in one Mass without the consent of the donors, very large numbers of intentions cannot be accepted at one time, and so forth.
