Thank you!!: Happy New Year! 2021 was an outstanding year for the STO and Catholic school families who rely on our tuition assistance. Your generosity to the Our Faith STO allowed us to meet our goal in mid-December of \$5,391,464. This total equates to over \$4 million worth of 2021 Iowa income tax credits distributed to donors helping families attend our Archdiocesan schools.

Your generosity also exceeded the amount given in 2020 by \$846,478! This additional amount will enable hundreds of extra students to receive STO tuition assistance for the 2022-23 school year. Did you know?: On average, in 2021, fewer donors gave more, pushing us to our goal and shutting others out of tax credits. Almost 300 donors from 2020 missed out on their opportunity to receive a tax credit in 2021. The 75% Iowa income tax credit remains a key benefit to our Catholic school supporters. If you missed out on tax credits in 2021, make it your New Year's resolution to donate earlier to ensure the tax credit benefit. **The STO is now accepting Pledge donations for 2022!** For the first time, the STO will be accepting pledge donations in 2022. Since many potential 2021 donors missed out on their tax credits last year, we've decided to now allow you to reserve credits for 2022 by pledging your donation. The STO will accept pledges until December 1, 2022, with payment for the contribution due no later than December 15, 2022. Credits reserved but without payment will be given to other donors after December 15, 2022.

Yo me recuerdo que en 2009 en California mi mamá fue diagnosticada con cáncer terminal etapa número cuatro. Lógicamente que para mi y el resto de mi familia fue algo muy doloroso el pensar que a alguien a quien queríamos mucho no tenía mucho tiempo para vivir. Es por esta razón que mi hermana y yo decidimos que era de suma importancia hablar si estábamos listos para enfrentar la partida de nuestra madre. Nos dimos cuenta que no estábamos listos espiritualmente ni con asuntos importantes como el funeral y los gastos que esto conlleva. Mi madre expresó su deseo de quedarse en el lugar en donde Dios la llamara a la vida eterna. Mi mamá al igual que mi papá eran personas prácticas y lógicas en los asuntos de la vida. No hay que dejar problemas económicos a la familia.

Aunque a mi mamá nunca expresó en palabras si era difícil aceptar su destino final pero con fe en Dios y la Santísima Virgen se enfrentó a la enfermedad diciéndome el día en que le dieron su diagnóstico final y segunda opinión médica. Me dijo “Agradezco al doctor por su opinión profesional como oncólogo pero el único doctor es el de arriba y Él sabe muy bien que va a hacer conmigo”. Esto me dio mucho consuelo saber que tanto ella como yo ya estábamos empezando esa preparación espiritual y emocional. Fue un trago fuerte tanto para mi como para ella porque yo estaba traduciendo todo.

Regresamos a la casa con esperanza de un mundo mejor pero derrotados por la realidad de la vida.

Hablamos de los momentos de alegría como familia y yo le dije tenemos que hablar de su partida porque yo quería escuchar sus deseos para sus exequias. Ella me dijo con mucha seguridad “Hijo yo no deseo dejarles gastos extras pero solamente deseo que ustedes se encarguen de hacer los arreglos y yo me encargo de mi preparación interna”.

Es así que mi hermana y yo empezamos a hablar acerca de los gastos y como hacerle para poder enfrentar todo. Gracias a Dios que mi hermana ya había comprado un lugar en el panteón y además tenía pagado un ataúd. Y aun más ya tenía adelantado un paquete prepagado de arreglos fúnebres el cual teníamos que hacer pagos lo más rápido posible porque el tiempo era muy coroto. Gracias a Dios que mi hermana, quien era la que cuidaba de mi mamá, pudo visualizar todo y me mantenía informado de todo los detalles y progreso de la salud. Y por supuesto que el resto de mis hermanos se mantenían informados porque ellos vivían fuera de Estado de California. Siempre existen personalidades en las familias. Unos de mis hermanos dijo porque están haciendo todo ahora en vez de esperar. Pero mi hermana y yo decidimos que no había mucho tiempo. La enfermedad estaba apresurándose rápidamente en todo el cuerpo. Es así como pudimos tomar decisiones y discutir las con el resto de la familia acerca de las opciones y gastos. Como sacerdote tenía que prepararme para el gran impacto emocional. Pero Dios nos fortaleció para poder hacer todo y darle la santa sepultura a un ser amado. La importancia de estar listos.
